- Consider different OS coverage since ABAP Platform 1809



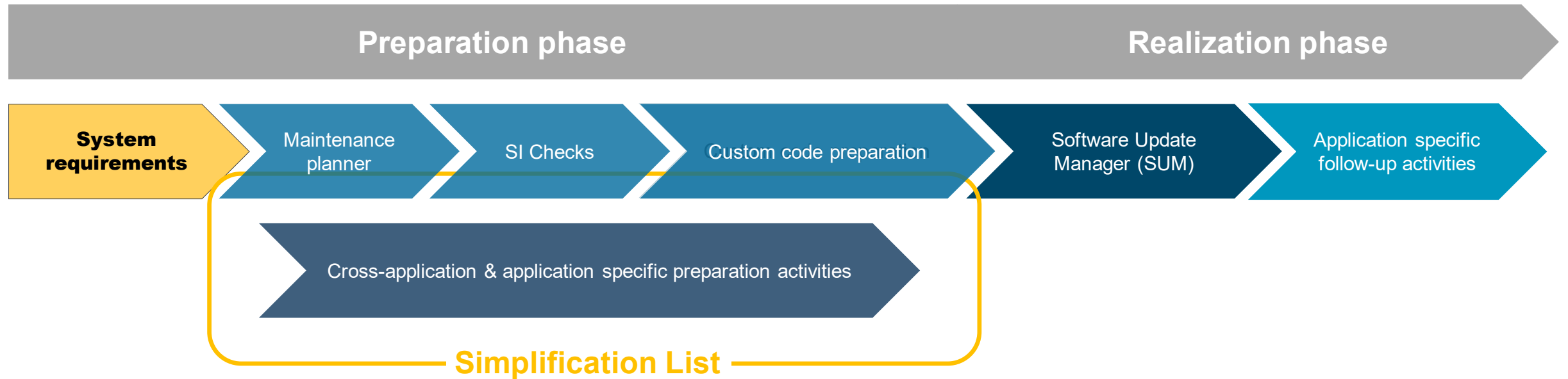

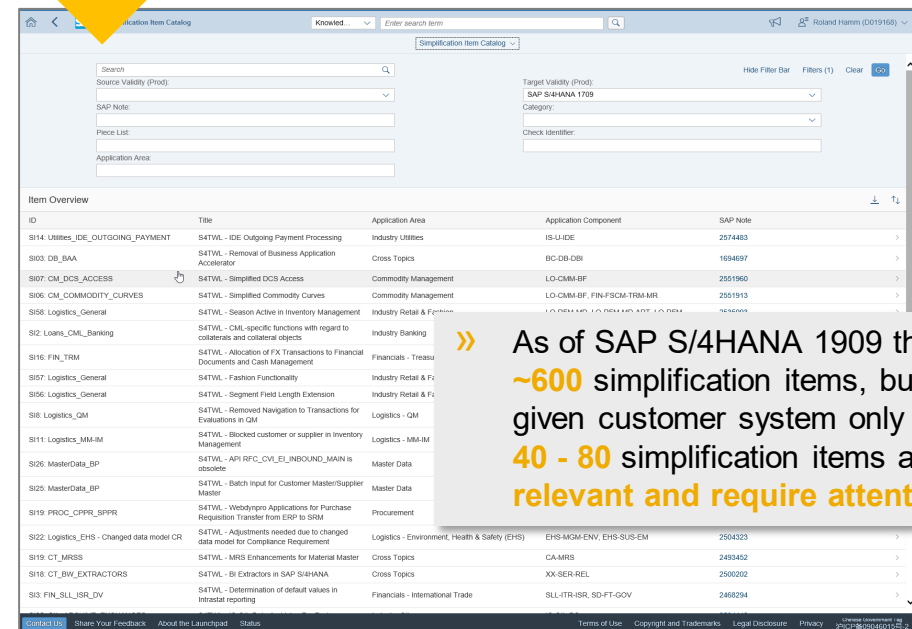
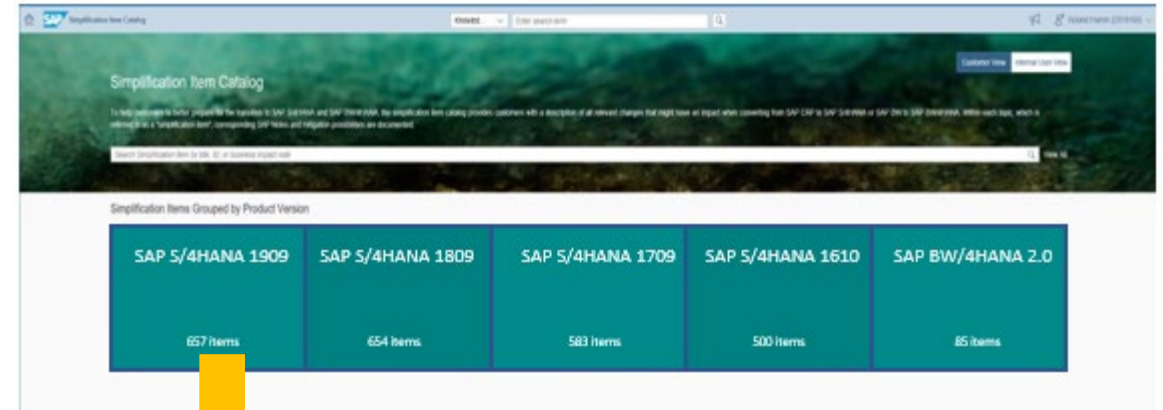
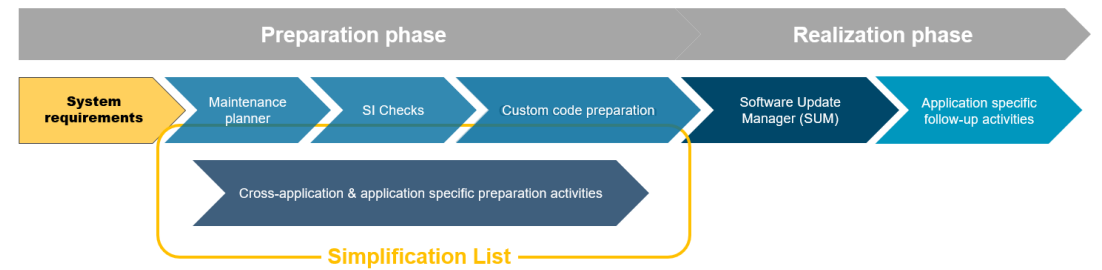
Simplification list

The **simplification list** is a collection of **simplification items**.

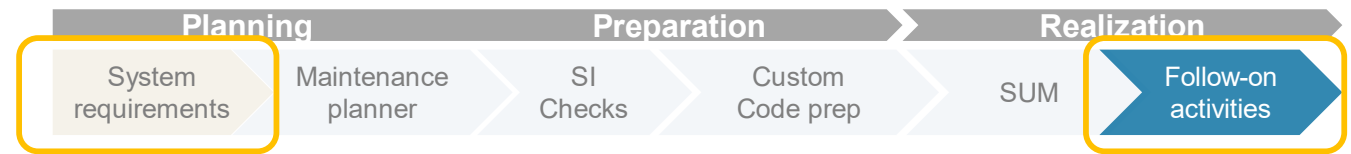
- A simplification item documents differences in application functionality (changed, replaced, removed) between SAP ERP 6.0 and SAP S/4HANA.
- A simplification item provides information about the potential impact of this change for the customer.
- The simplification list provides this information per SAP S/4HANA On-Premise release as part of the SAP S/4HANA documentation.
- The **SAP Readiness Check for SAP S/4HANA**, the **SAP ABAP custom code analysis**, as well as the **simplification item checks** are based on the information in the simplification items.

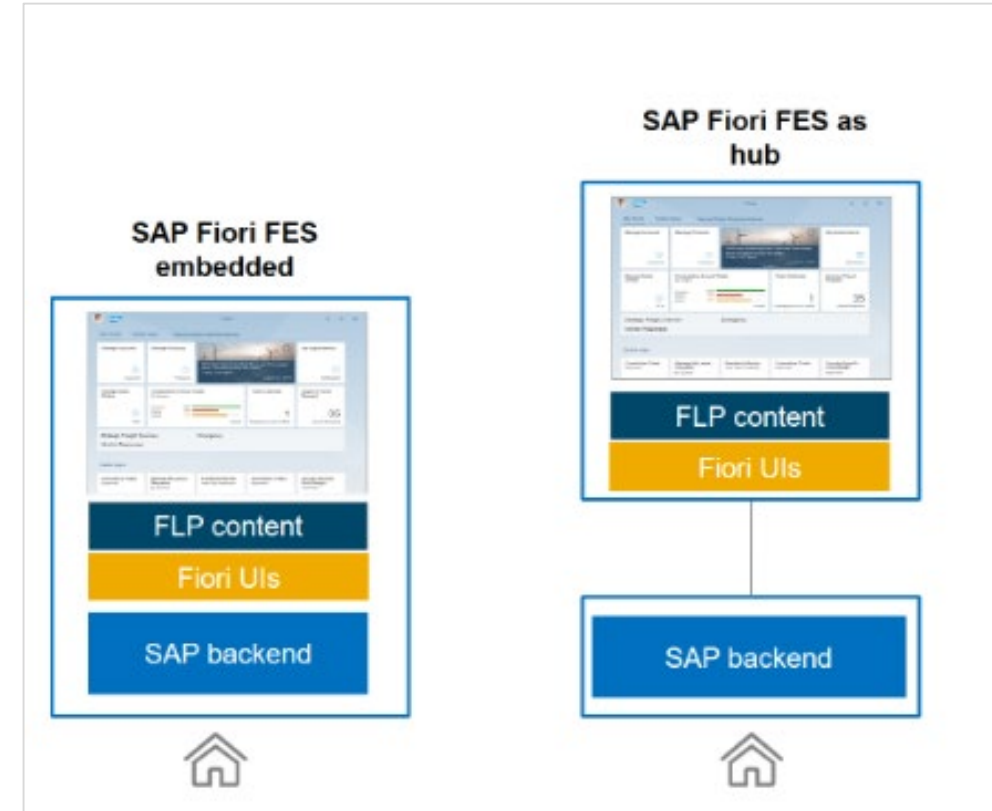

SAP S/4HANA - FIORI aspects



- **SAP Fiori UX is new UI experience**, target architecture for SAP S/4HANA
- **SAP Fiori and SAP GUI** are both supported (for exceptions see *Simplification List*)
- **Relevance and readiness analysis** recommends Fiori Apps based on T-codes
- **Stepwise implementation** of SAP Fiori Apps possible
- **SAP Fiori Frontend Server (FES)**
 - Provides Fiori & central UI components
 - Maintenance planner considers FES software
- **FES deployment:** embedded or separate, depends on other backends (type & release)

- Preparations for conversion: Check and plan
- Checking source system concerning add-ons, business functions
License for SAP S/4HANA not required for check
- Planning for conversion provides software archives & stack.xml
Backend and frontend server (FIORI) are considered
- Un-installation of add-ons can be planned;
3rd party add-ons to be checked in time!



SAP S/4HANA system conversion

Simplification Item Checks



- Simplification item ('SI') checks are shipped as SAP TCI Notes.
- SI-checks are executed on the (SAP Business Suite) start system (preparation phase) to **determine relevant simplification items and mandatory application specific preparation steps.**
- Check if serious issues exist in the system which could cause the system conversion/upgrade to fail.
- Support **not only system conversions** to SAP S/4HANA, but **also upgrades** within SAP S/4HANA
- SI-Checks are executed again as step in the Software Update Manager (SUM). In case dedicated simplification items require mandatory preparation steps the conversion procedure can stop to ensure a consistent system conversion.

Relevance Check

Consistency Check

SAP note 2399707
Contains the check framework including the logic for the relevance checks.

SAP note 2502552
Contains application specific check logic for the consistency checks.

Simplification Item Catalog
Check content downloaded from SAP servers.

Relevance check:

- Identifies probably relevant Simplification Items based on an analysis of the data in the system.
- For informational purpose, so customers know which Simplification Items and related SAP notes to have a closer look at.

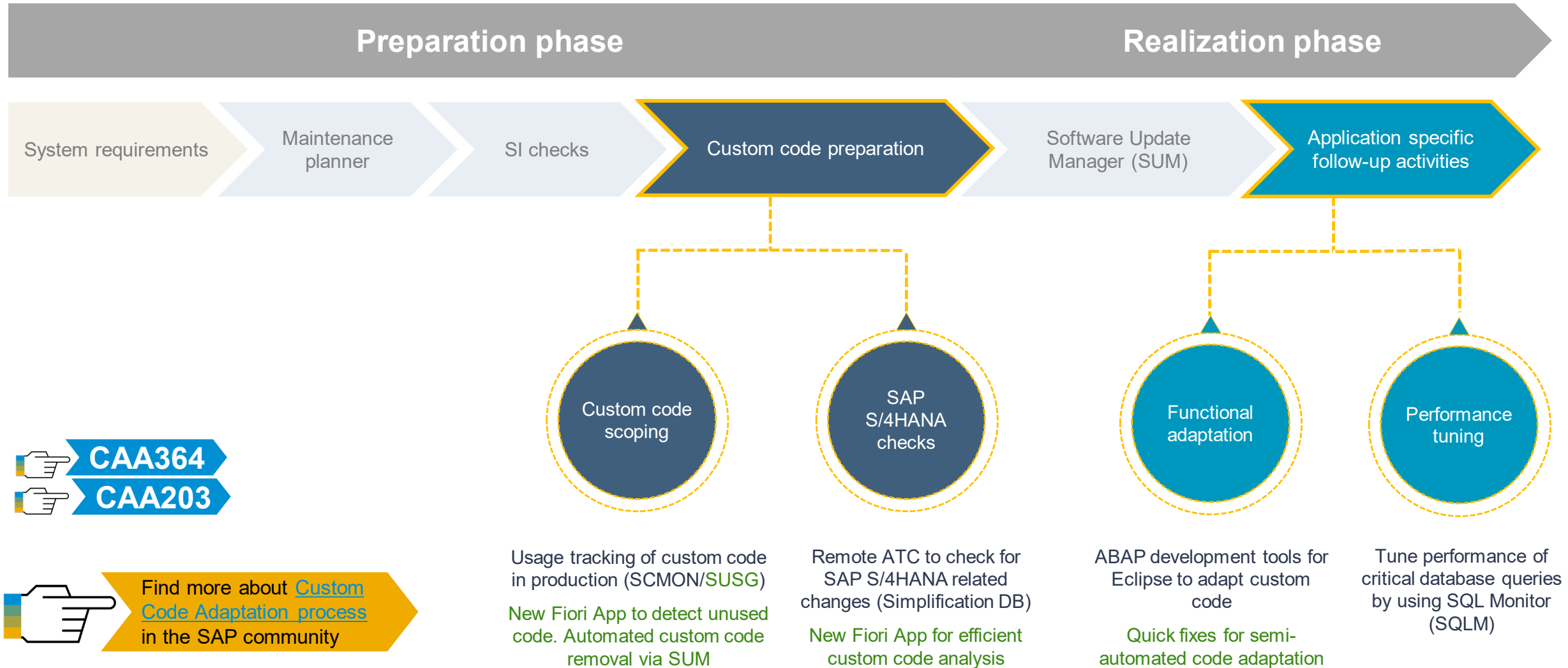
Consistency check:

- Identify critical issues which could prevent a successful system conversion and where an action from customer side is required.
- Will prevent Software Update Manager from going into the downtime, if not all critical errors are fixed or exempted.

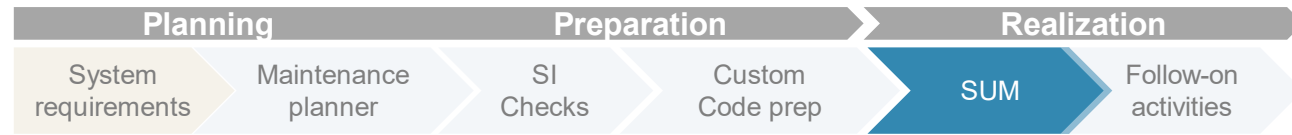
Data conversion as part of system conversion



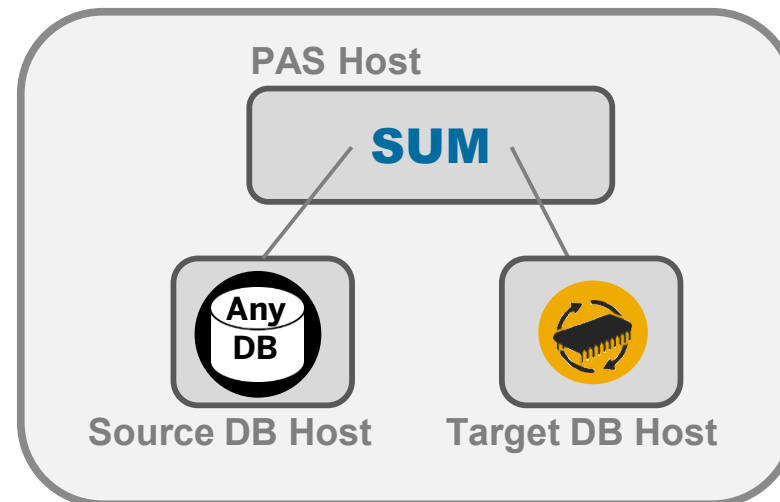
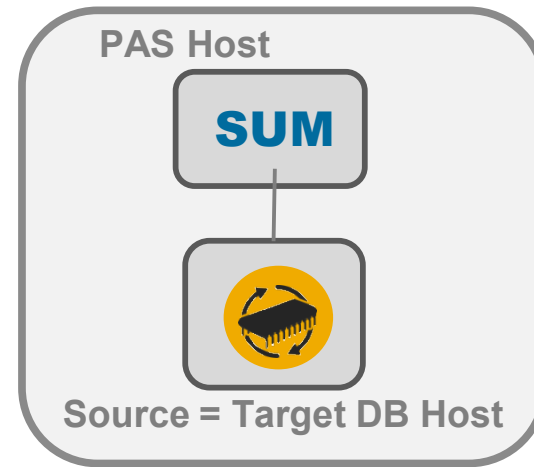
- Transition of business data (table content) into tables of the new data model - examples:
 - GLT0, FAGLFLEXA, FAGLFLEXA -> ACDOCA (Universal Journal)
 - MKPF, MSEG -> MATDOC
- Handling of “old” tables depends on the application area
 - Some old tables may no longer be used
 - Some fields of old tables may still be used
- Concept of “Obsolete Data Handling”, see SAP Note 2661837

SAP S/4HANA system conversion

Technical conversion by Software Update Manager (SUM)

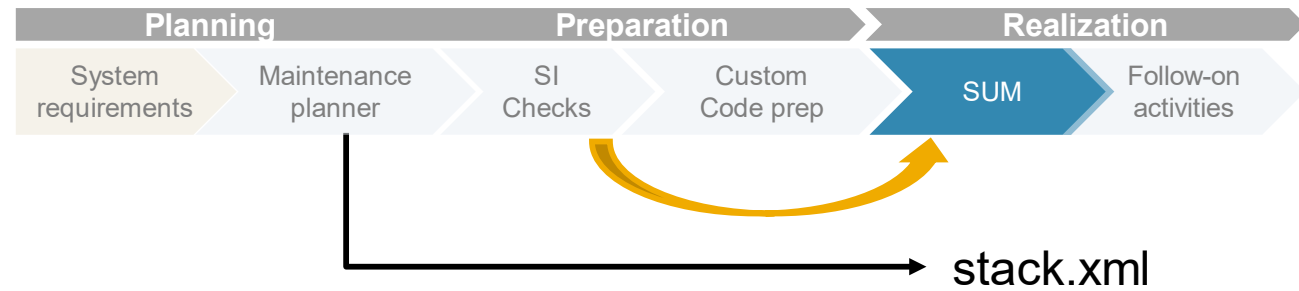


- Conversion tasks for SUM:
 - **Software update**
Provide new applications and new tables
 - **Data conversion**
Conversion of table content to new data model
 - **Database migration**
Migrate to SAP HANA database (if required)



SAP S/4HANA system conversion

Technical conversion prerequisites



- **Maintenance planner:** provides stack.xml and software archives
- **SI checks:** will be executed by SUM as well -> solve all issues before

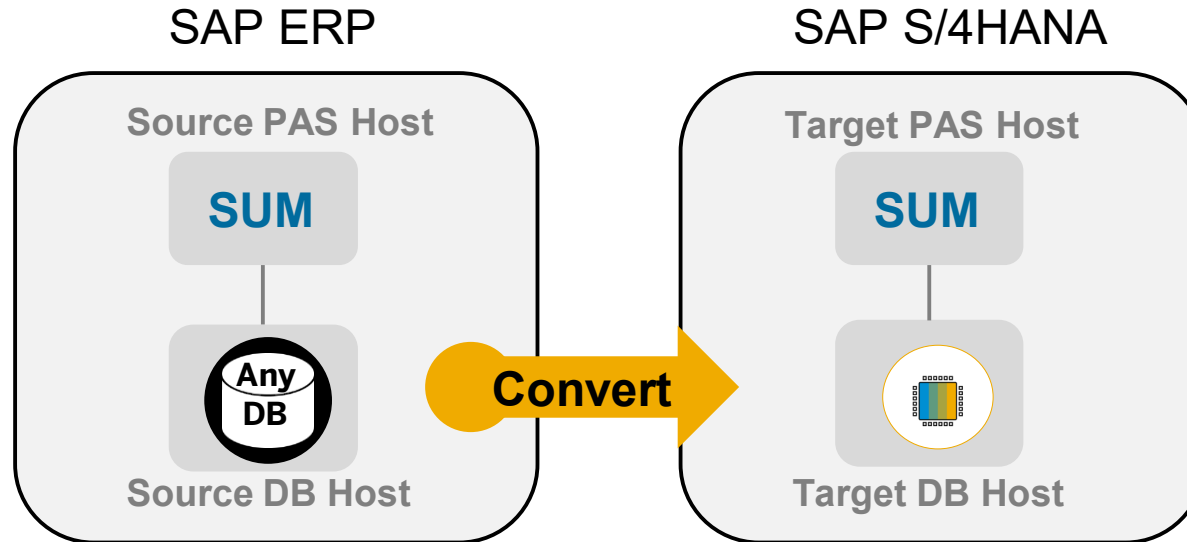
Optional activities (depending on system type)

- **Readiness check:** is optional, but strongly recommended!
- **Custom code check:** may be ignored, e.g. for a sandbox conversion run
- **SUM prerequisite check:** check of OS/DB- and SPAM requirements

DMO with system move

Possible option for a system conversion



DMO with system move allows to switch the complete system (esp. AppServer host):

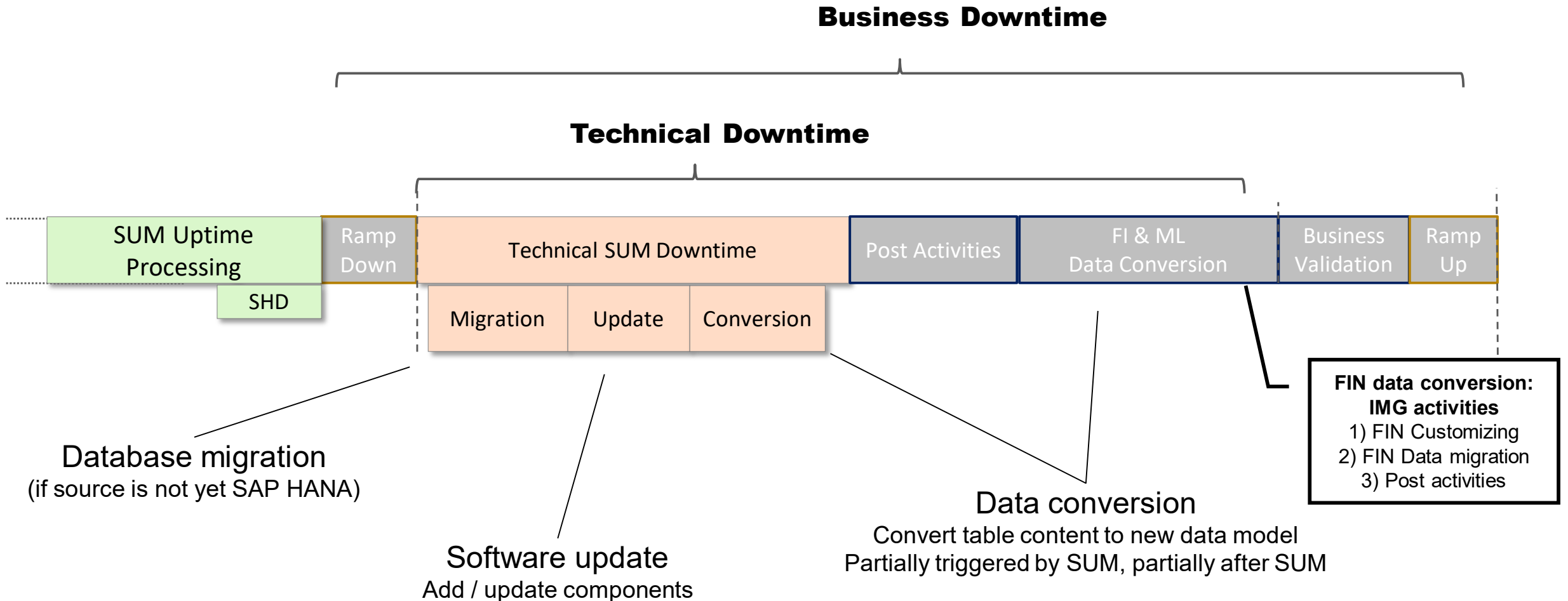
- From one host to a different host (e.g. hardware change)
- From one data center to a different one
- From on-premise to Cloud (IAAS)


DMO with system move for target SAP S/4HANA **1909** is not supported with SUM 2.0 SP **06**, but it will be supported with a later SUM SP version

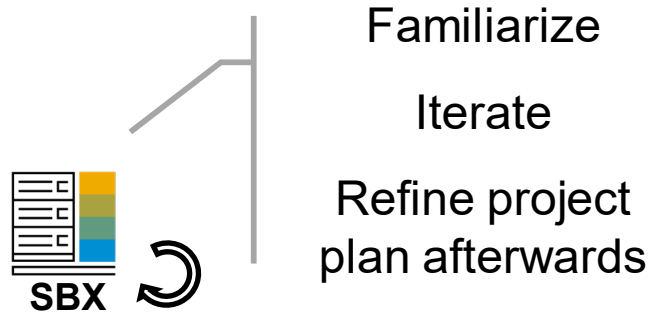

Consider dual maintenance



Business function testing of new/adapted processes

Goal: SUM SP version shall not be switched in critical phase
4 to 8 months maintenance => relevant systems to be converted therein

Consider dress rehearsal



Aspects to consider



Time

- Simplification Item clearance
- Workshops, end user training
- 3rd party Add-on support check
- Archiving and deprecation of custom code to be considered



Knowledge

- Plan project as joint project (Tec & Biz) from the very beginning
- Colleagues with broad knowledge of Finance, Controlling & Asset Accounting required



Testing

- 2 to 3 test conversions on a sandbox/isolated system, with business tests on target
- Tests for roles and authorization changes
- Plan Dress Rehearsal
(test conversion of productive system under real-time conditions)
