Road Map Priorities

Empowering workers on the Move with SAP Maintenance Assistant

SAP Maintenance Assistant is a native mobile app for technicians to manage various tasks, including handling work orders and operations, creating and managing maintenance requests, and assessing priorities. The app empowers workers on the move: it allows them to download relevant data on their phone and gives them the ability to work effectively offline. Not only does this make the workforce more flexible and efficient, it also cuts back significantly on paperwork. In addition, with the object picker in notifications to maintenance technicians, we can help them leverage machine learning algorithms to propose likely failure codes in the maintenance notification. This, combined with predictive maintenance by automatically analyzing information already collected during the maintenance process, not only increases the quality of data but improves user performance and maximizes efficiency for the customer.


To view a Road Map:



- Innovations are organized by business capabilities. Business capabilities are listed *alphabetically*.

Time Horizon:

- **Relative Section:** You can choose First-Current, First-Last, or Current-Last, to automatically show innovations ranging from the first and last quarter.*
- **Absolute Section:** Manually select the range of quarters.
- ***Note:** “First” and “Last” filters indicate the first and last quarter in the tool. This can change with time (i.e. Currently, the last quarter is 2023 but next year, the last quarter can be 2024).


Kanban Board: Personalization

Favorite an Innovation:

- Click on the “star” button on the top right corner of the innovation box to easily spot it on the Kanban board.

Innovation Set:

- Create an innovation set and organize your selected innovations with the “+” button.
- You do not need to favorite an innovation to add it to an innovation set.




View and share your Innovation Set:




