What is the General Data Protection Regulation?



The General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (EU Regulation 2016/679), effective May 25, 2018, gives individuals control and protection of their personal data. Data controllers, who determine the purpose and means of processing personal data, and processors, who process for controllers, are affected.



Penalties up to 4% of annual global revenue or €20 million whichever is greater



Who must comply?

Organizations that offer goods or services to, or monitor the behavior of, EU data subjects and those that process or hold the personal data of EU residents

Applies to:

Natural persons, whatever their nationality or place of residence in the EU, in relation to the processing of their personal data




Get started quickly while enabling a sustainable GDPR program

Monitor: Manage and report

- Sustainable processes, continuous improvement, and change management
- Self-assessments and internal audit of compliance
- Reporting for DPO and internal/external stakeholders

Respond: Execute on your plan

- Appropriate tools for your DPO
- Required data protection, security, and access governance
- Required data subject interactions to protect rights
- Updated policies, procedures, internal controls, and training



Assess: Understand what you have

- GDPR requirements for your company
- Personal data and the business or legal need for it
- Privacy-related policies and procedures
- Existing systems to protect data

Plan: Find gaps and plan solutions

- GDPR requirements not met
- Data protection impact assessments (DPIA) to focus efforts
- Authorization and access management
- System and application alternatives to fill gaps, prioritized based upon risk and critical path


