


Enabling Generative AI features in Integration Settings





Script Optimization feature for Script Collection

- You can now optimize the Groovy scripts of your script collections using Generative AI.

Runtime Selection for Access Policies

- You can now choose the specific runtime where you want to define access policies.
- You can copy existing access policies into Edge Integration Cell runtimes.

Other updates

• You can now choose how to process empty files. You can process it like any other file, skip it completely or skip it the primary processing while still generating a Message Processing Log and executing post-processing tasks only.

You can now choose to use the same target root element as the incoming payload in the outgoing payload.


- Removed leading zeros from IDoc number in ApplicationID
- Option to switch off "tilde option" for the partner ID allowing scenario names only
- Changed the default inbound processing queue to follow our recommendation to use the Integrated Messaging Runtime pipeline instead of the fully decoupled pipeline
- Supporting service interface namespaces to identify partner ID based on system name, service interface name and service interface namespace for XI inbound scenarios


- Reworked the custom header properties to support special characters in the custom header property values
- Added custom header property QualityOfService for XI inbound scenarios
- Updated the allowed header list for the provided template flows




