Cloud Integration

Update Version of Integration Flow Components

This enhancement is designed to make integration process development easier by enabling the integration developers to access the latest features through seamless updates of integration flow adapters and flow steps. It offers the following:

- **Applicable Components:** This feature is available for various components, including integration flow configuration, integration process, local integration process, exception subprocess, integration flow steps, and integration adapters.
- **Viewing Older Versions:** If you want to view the older version, you must save the integration flow as a version before migrating to the new version.
- **Retention of Old Fields:** When you update the version, old fields will be retained with the same values, and new fields will be populated with default values. If a default value is not present for a mandatory field, you must add the value.
- **Component Compatibility:** Components with incompatible features won't be migrated. You need to remove and add the component while maintaining its properties manually.

SFTP Sender Adapter Enhancements

- You can now use **advanced** timer in Scheduler for SFTP Sender Adapter version 1.20 and above respectively.
- You can now set **read lock interval** for SFTP Sender Adapter to pause between attempts to acquire a read lock. If the lock cannot be acquired within this timeout, file processing is skipped and attempted again during the next polling cycle.
- You can now use **regex filtering** to evaluate the entered filename as a real expression or a simple expression in Source for SFTP Sender Adapter used with the Poll Enrich step version 1.8 and above.

B2B - Integration Advisor

Base and overlay mapping

- Managing and maintaining B2B integration mappings for many different business partners is inefficient.
- Each partner often requires small, specific variations of a standard interface (like EDIFACT or ANSI X12).
- Creating a new, full mapping from scratch for each partner is time-consuming and error-prone.



- Base Mapping ("Template")
- Overlay Mapping ("Partner-Specific" Layer)
- Can be used in TPM



B2B - Integration Advisor

MIG creation based on multiple payloads

- Save time with single Payload upload for MIG creation (including qualification)
- Now several payloads can be uploaded
 - One zip with up to 10MB max 25 Payloads
- More variants of payload are then used to create MIG and qualifiers

B2B – Trading Partner Management

flexible configuration of keys

- Enable highly granular partner and transaction differentiation
- Extract any value (e.g., plant code, country) from message payloads using Xpath
- **Create** custom keys with a simple wizard, selecting any node/field from sample messages
- **Assign** rules to agreements for precise routing and partner resolution
- **Support** for GS1 XML, S/4HANA SOAP, S/4HANA IDoc
- **Easily manage** activation, sequence, and deactivation of rules in the UI
- **No more limitations:** Go beyond standard fields (sender ID, type, etc.)

B2B – Trading Partner Management

Role enhancements for Monitoring

- Especially payloads might be sensitive
- Not everybody should be able to get access to payloads
- New role: **B2bInterchangePayloadRead**

Role Template	Role Collection	Actions
B2bInterchangeRead	PI_Integration_Developer, PI_Read_Only	Read interchanges without payloads
B2bInterchangePayloadRead	Not included in a role collection	Read interchange payloads
B2bInterchangeOperate	PI_Business_Expert	Execute operational tasks on interchanges, such as retry, restart, or cancel






