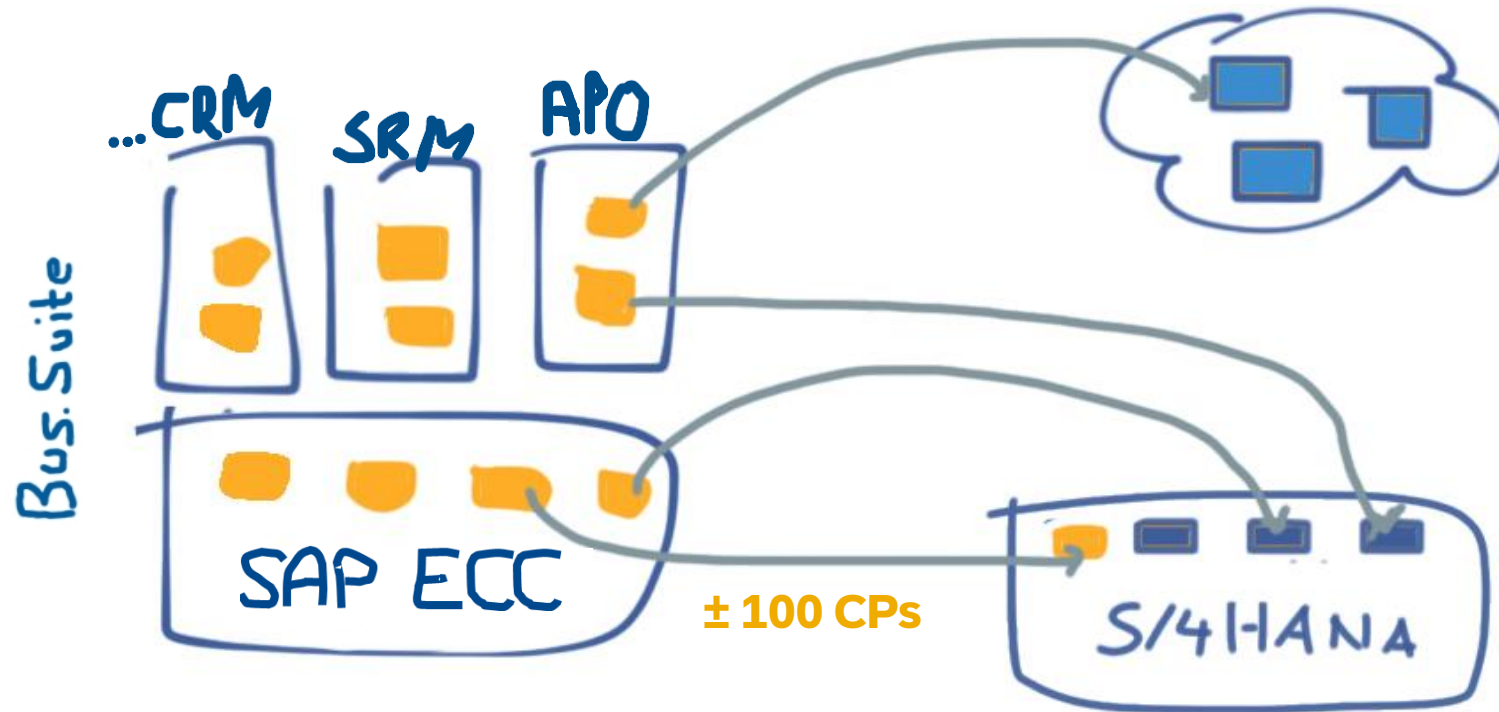

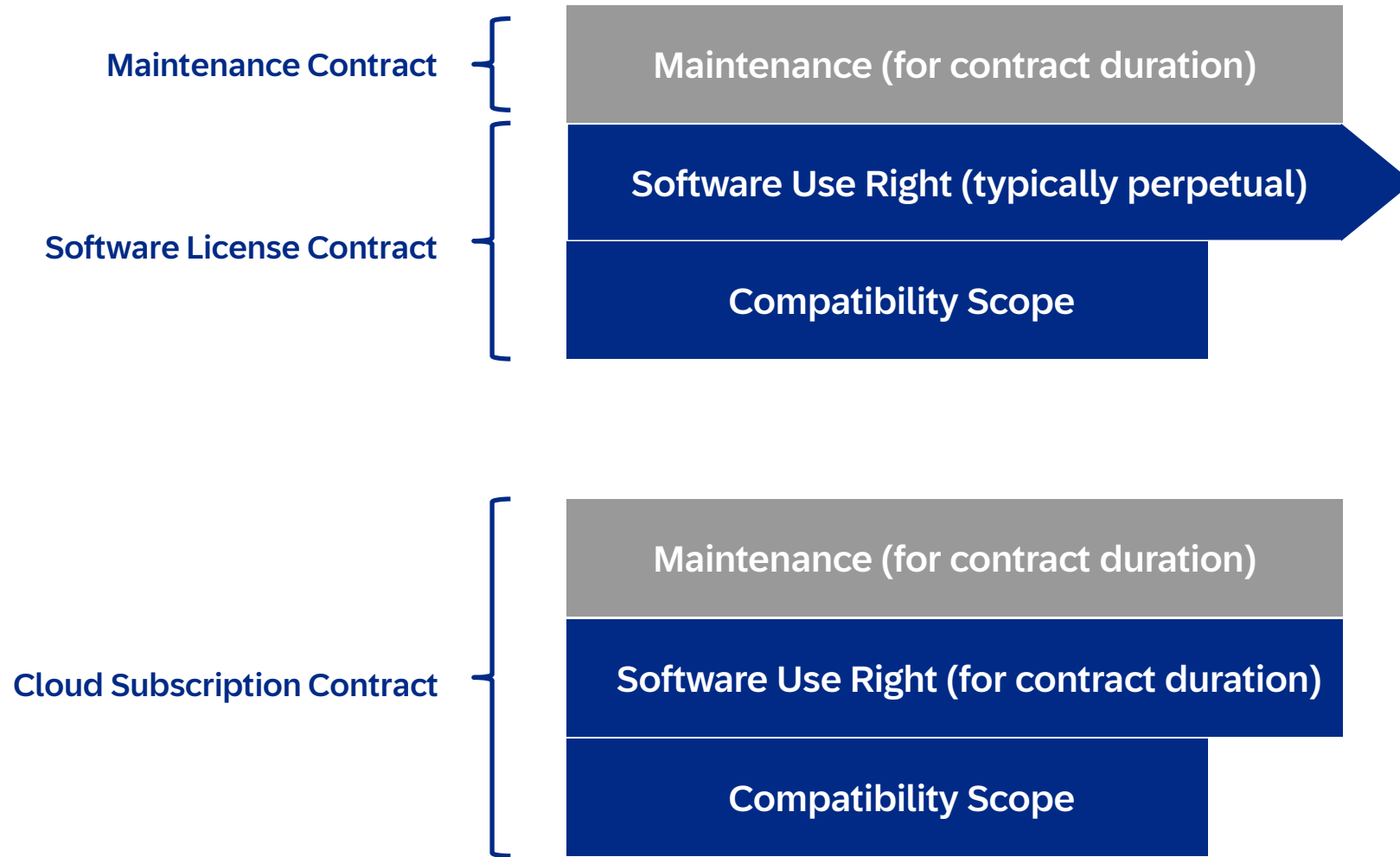

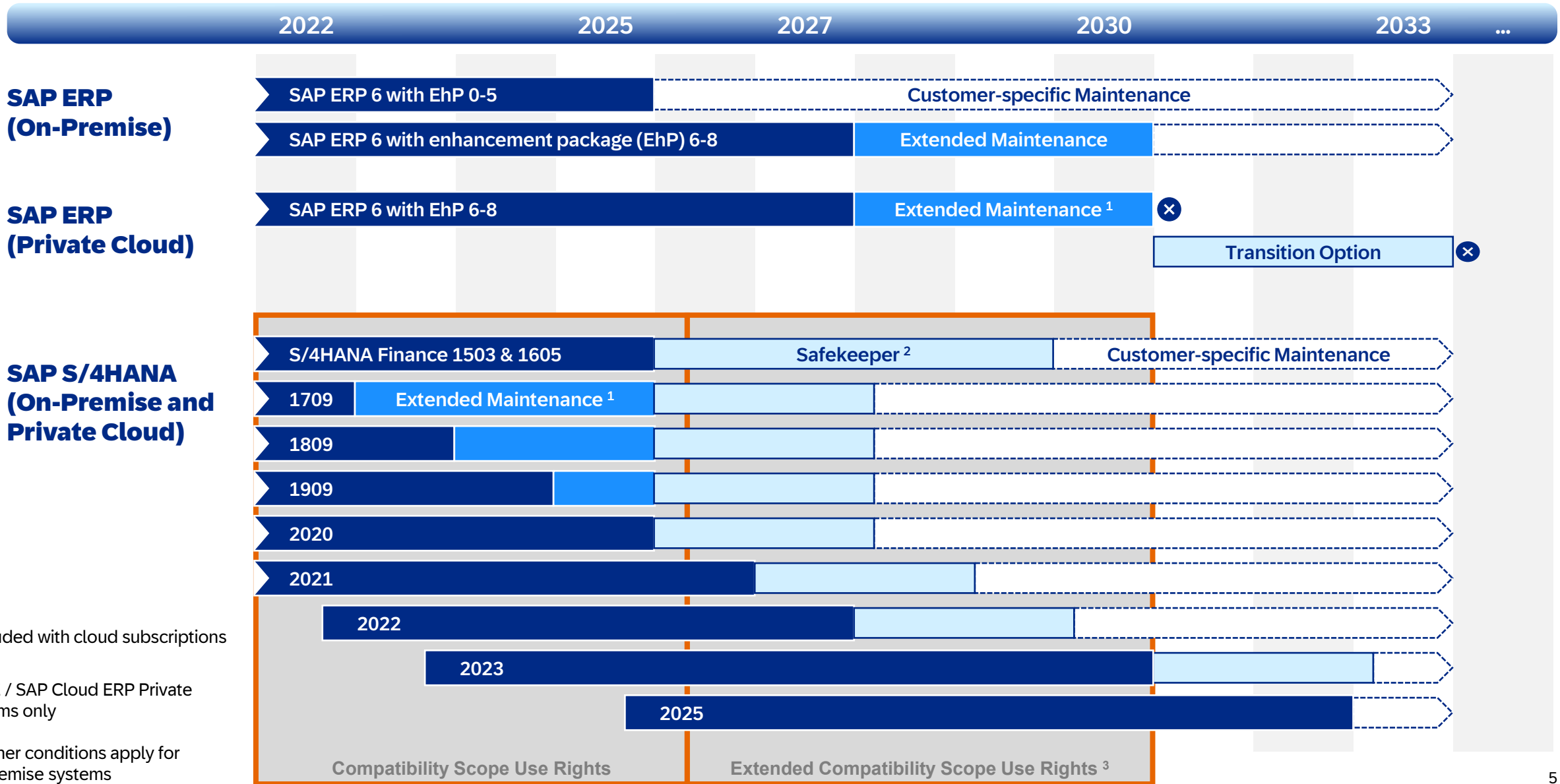
Compatibility Packs (CPs) define legacy SAP ERP “ECC” functionality that has been made available in S/4HANA (On-Premise and Private Cloud) for a defined period.

After the defined end date, the USE RIGHT to the solution expires (not only the maintenance!).

Maintenance Timelines



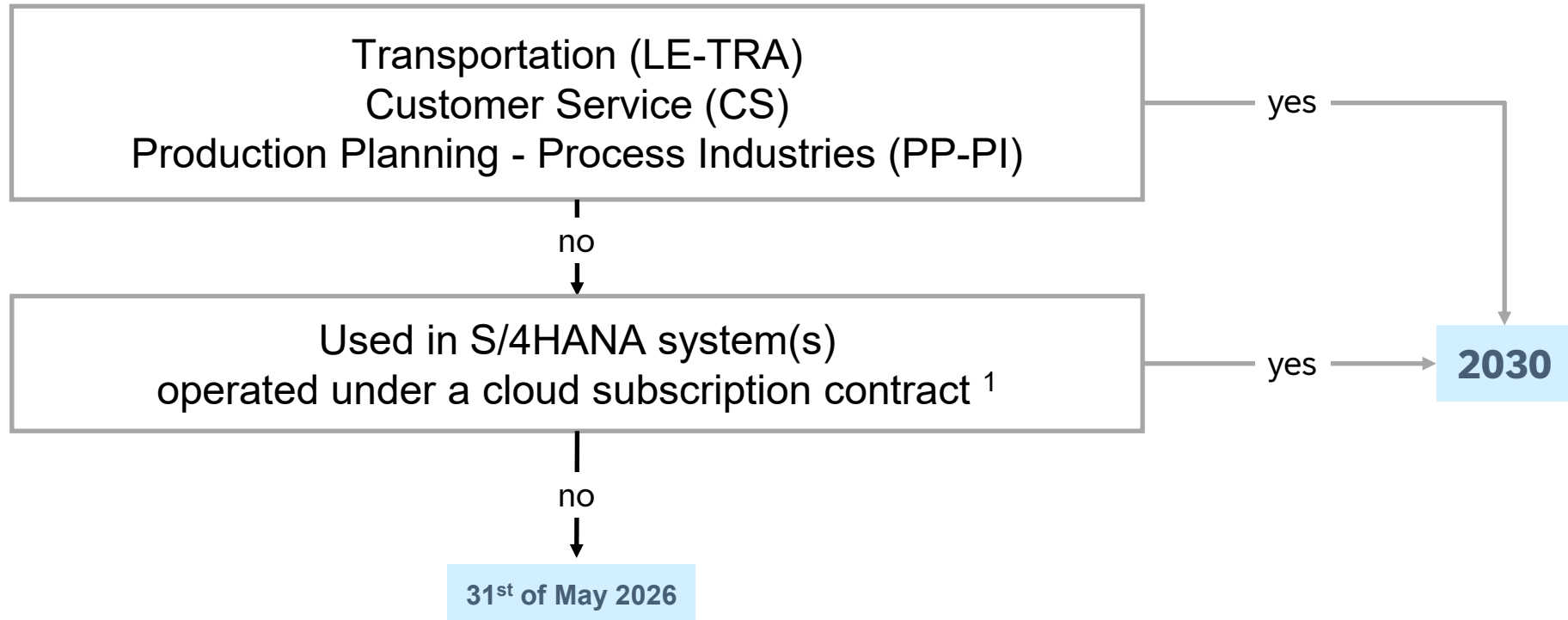
