

 2027. Extended maintenance can be provided until the
 end of 2030.

Recommended actions to customers today:

- Move to SAP Process Orchestration 7.5, the long-term supported release as previous versions went out of maintenance at the end of 2020.
- Complement it with SAP Integration Suite for agile integrations and leverage the cloud integration runtime within SAP Process Orchestration.



Migration Assessment Capability of SAP Integration Suite





- Data extraction (ESR & Integration Directory) directly connecting to SAP Process Orchestration systems
- Evaluation based on flexible rules framework
 - Set of characteristics reflecting feature parity
 - Each rule has a weight impacting overall migration effort
 - More rules to be added in future
- Migration effort in t-shirt size and person days
 - Covers technical migration only
 - Based on experience from the field
 - Effort reduction due to similarity of scenarios (learning curve)
- Evaluation results
 - Dashboard, pdf & excel download
 - Statistics of scenarios by assessment categories, effort estimation, adapter types



Assessment categories*

Ready to Migrate

- Scenarios match to scenarios offered in SAP Integration Suite
- Can be moved to SAP Integration Suite manually or semiautomatically
- Additional configuration steps might be required

Adjustment Required

- Partially match to scenarios supported by SAP Integration Suite
- Can be moved to SAP Integration Suite manually or semiautomatically
- Further adjustments to end-to-end integration process based on best practices are required
- Example: As File adapter is not supported, we would propose SFTP as alternative

Evaluation Required

- No match or match not known, some items require further evaluation
- Example: Since In Order processing is not supported yet, scenario can't be migrated
- <u>Example</u>: For custom adapter modules we are not able to do an automatic assessment

^{*} NOTE: Assessment category is an indication of the ease of "migratability" and not an indication of what the migration tool can automate

Migration Tooling

Concepts


- Migration wizard embedded in Cloud Integration designer
- Integration flows are semi-automatically created based on set of integration flow templates
- Framework automatically identifies fitting template; more than one template can be applicable
- Default template to at least upload mappings incl. message structures
- SAP Process Orchestration adapter metadata attributes are mapped to channel properties of Cloud Integration
- Manual adjustments such as maintaining security artifacts may be needed after integration flow creation

Migration supported for following components

- Configuration artifact: Integrated Configuration Object
- Mode: Synchronous & Asynchronous
- Communication Channels: HTTP, REST, SOAP, IDOC, FTP, and SFTP
- Events: Message Start, Message End, Timer
- Mappings: XSLT, Message Mapping incl. source and target structures
- Converters: XML to JSON, JSON to XML
- Misc.: Router
- More components to be added in future such as support for XI adapter







Extend SAP Integration Suite in customer environments






