







Change Control Management innovations

Consistent clean up of imported transport requests in STMS import queue

Description

- After a transport request is fully imported into the target system, it still stays in the import queue with status "Request already imported".

Details

- With the activation of the import feedback mechanism, fully imported transport requests (without import error and without re-import flag) are *automatically removed* from the import queue.

Change Control Management innovations

Housekeeping for import logs collected via the import feedback mechanism

Description

- The enhanced housekeeping logic will remove old and obsolete import logs collected via the import feedback mechanism.
- Request [272326](#)

Details

- Schedule the SM:TMWFLOW_CMSSYSCOL job in SOLMAN_SETUP to run daily.
- Define a value of retention days for your import feedback jobs.
- Only the import detail (step) logs are removed. The main import log stays in the system so that your change process is not affected.

Release Planning – Display only Open Release Cycles

Description

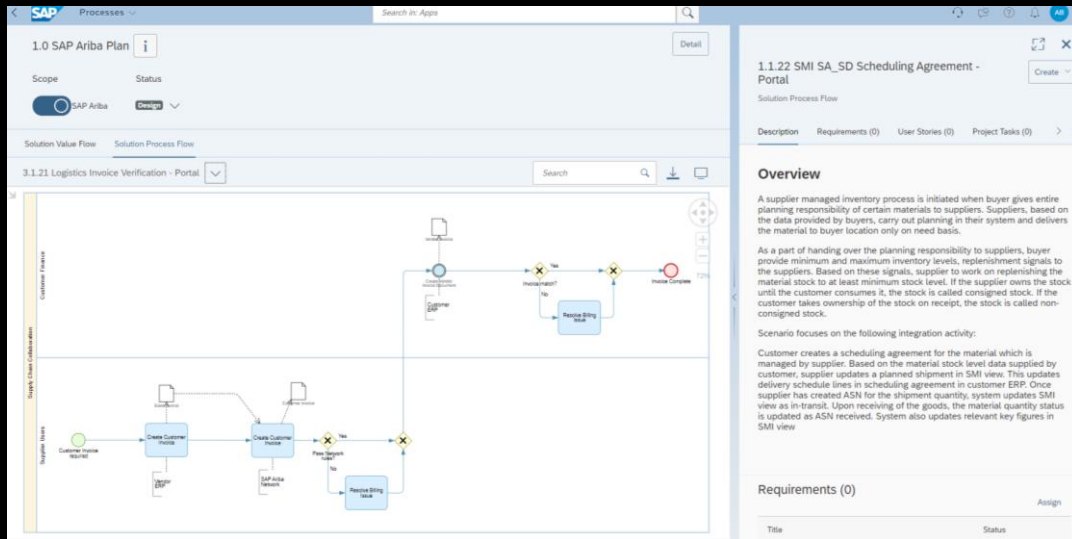

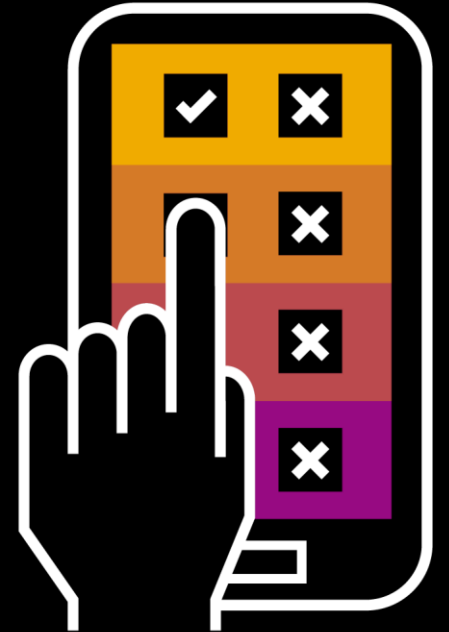

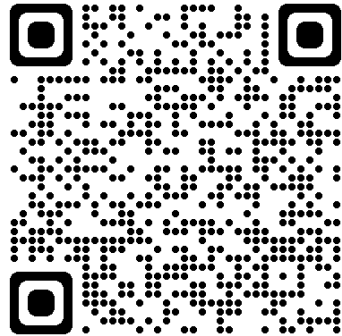
