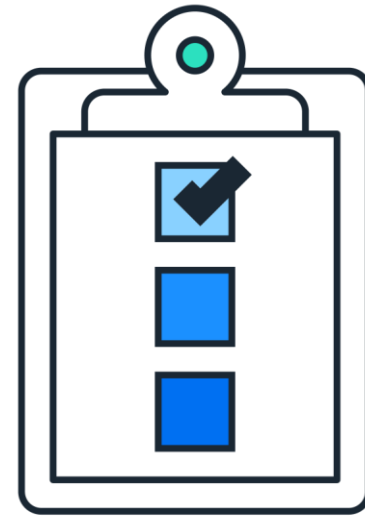

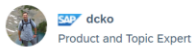

## Cross-solution SAP Activate Roadmaps with Cloud ALM

For several years, SAP customers and partners have relied on SAP Activate roadmaps as a valuable source of guidance for implementing products. Traditionally, these roadmaps were authored and consumed on a per-product basis. However, as projects increasingly involve the integration of multiple products, a new solution is required.

With the recent feature release of **SAP Cloud ALM** and the innovative Activate authoring capabilities, a significant enhancement has been realized. It is now possible to seamlessly combine multiple roadmaps into a single, comprehensive project. This breakthrough not only streamlines the implementation process but also offers a more holistic approach for projects that extend across different SAP products.

### How to create a cross solution roadmap:

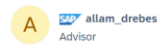
1. In the SAP Cloud ALM 'Project and Setup' app, create a new project.
2. Enter the 'Project Name'
3. Using the drop-down for the SAP Activate Roadmap field, select 'Combinable Roadmaps'. These roadmaps are eligible to be combined.
4. Select the roadmaps that are included in your project.
5. Save the combined roadmap.

Hello Everyone,

In this blog post I would like to show the steps to provision a Selenium Runner in a private landscape and connect it to Cloud ALM using SAP Cloud Connector.

This blog post will directly shows configuration steps, for an details about Synthetic User Monitoring solution, refer to [SAP Expert Portal](#).

The overall steps to provision the runner are the following:

- Provision SAP Cloud Connector in Landscape & SSL Certificate Configuration
- Register SAP Cloud ALM BTP Subaccount in provisioned SAP Cloud Connector
- Provision Selenium Server with required components (OS, Browsers and Webdrivers)
- Define connection mapping in Cloud Connector for the Selenium address
- Configure Cloud Connector in Cloud ALM Landscape Management
- Configure Runner in SAP Cloud ALM

You are ready to record scripts and deploy for execution in the provisioned runner

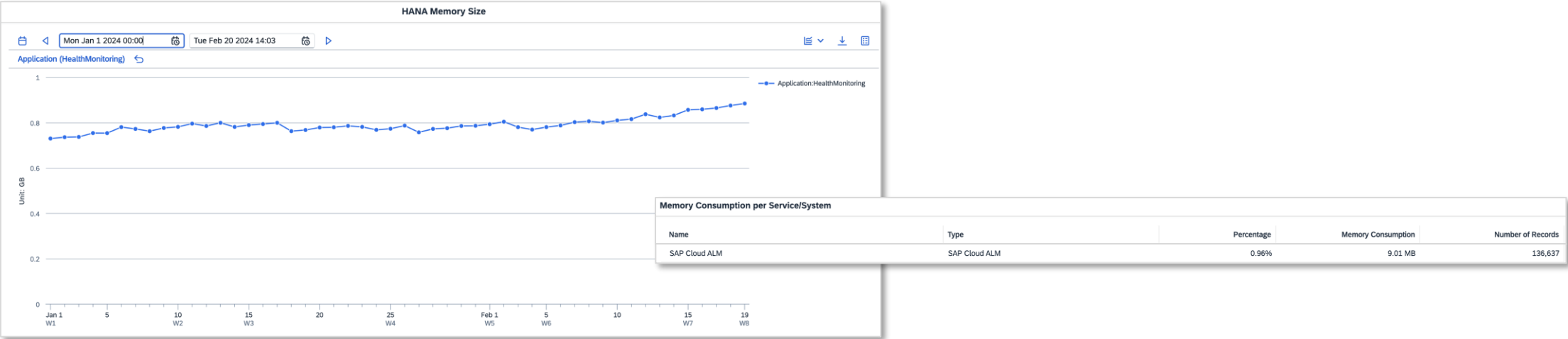

# Quality Gates in SAP Cloud ALM

- Prepare and manage quality gates via task type 'Quality Gate'.
- Measure the completeness and accuracy of the deliverables and artifacts using Checklists. Checklist can be created manually or via excel upload.
- Action items from a quality gate check can be captured via follow-up tasks.
- Track the progress of quality gate checks via the Quality Gates card in the project overview.

The purpose of the Quality Gate is to ensure that both compliance and project management standards are being upheld within projects. A Quality Gate is a checklist milestone at the end of a project phase. Prior to moving into the next phase each project manager demonstrates that they have been compliant with the mandatory deliverables associated with a methodology while ensuring best practice standards have been applied to ensure quality.

**Procedure:**

1. Review the **QGate Checklist Concept SAP Activate** accelerator to ensure an understanding on what should be covered during the Quality Gate. Areas covered should include:
  - Specifically checking deliverables been completed with recommended practices.
  - Assuring project planning.
  - Validating open risks and issues, and measuring customer satisfaction.
2. Conduct the Quality Gate utilizing the applicable **Quality Gate Template** accelerator.

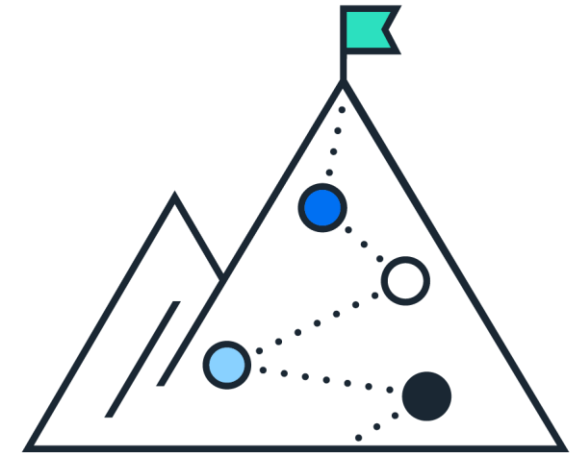

# Quality Gates: Difference between SAP Solution Manager and SAP Cloud ALM

- Quality Gate Management (QGM) in SAP Solution Manager provides an integrated and consistent quality process to manage changes and their deployment over all operational units across the various organizations of a company.
- Quality gates in Cloud ALM are critical checkpoints used to ensure the project's deliverables meet the predefined quality standards before moving to the next phase. It is associated with the phases of a project defined by the SAP Activate Methodology.
- Quality gates in Cloud ALM supports early detection of issues within projects and risk mitigation, and promotes project governance by standardizing processes and improving accountability.
