Customer Story: A Template / Rollout approach



SAP S/4 HANA Implementation @ HABERKORN Group

- S/4 HANA private cloud edition, greenfield
- project start January 2022
- 140 project members (internal / external)
- 4 different Germany located subsidiaries / **rollouts**
- scheduled project end July 2025
- finale rollout merge to an HABERKORN **template**
- HK template for **upcoming rollouts**



Template / Rollout – strategy

In General

Template

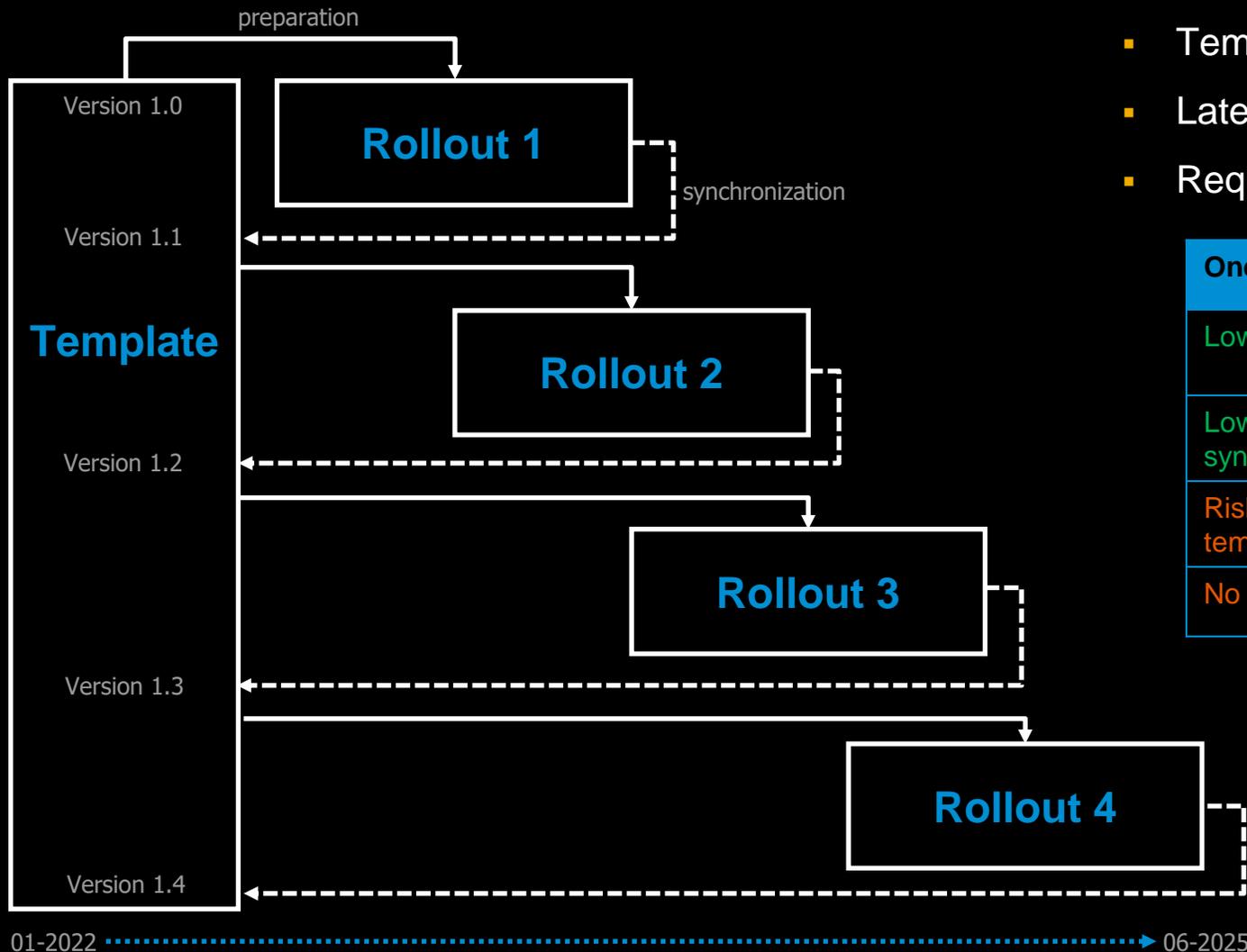
- template as baseline for solution rollouts
- separate system landscape per region (not valid at HK)
- defined scope of solution processes + documentation
- bundle of configuration (~ requirements) related to solution processes
- ownership (LOB)
- CAB (requirements approval)

Rollout

- consumer of template
- localization
- template solution process and requirements not changeable
- initial shipment one-time

Template / Rollout – concept

Customer needs



- Template processes / configuration valid for all rollouts
- Template adjustments during rollout (CAB approval)
- Latest template version for next rollout preparation
- Requirement defines configuration (no user story)

One Project	Multiple Projects
Low effort to manage content	High effort to manage content
Low effort template synchronization	High effort template synchronization
Risk of unauthorized template changes	Authorized template changes only
No separate versioning	Versioning by project

Template / Rollout – Project and Releases

(1) One Cloud ALM Project **S/4 HANA** contains Template and Rollout

(2) Scope as frame of *sub-project*.

- LOGISTIC - **MLS**
- LOGISTIC - **SLO**

} 4 Rollouts shipment
by different releases

Deployment Plans:

TPL release 1.0

SAL release 1.1 Go-live 12-2023

MLB release 1.2 Go-live 04-2024

MLS release 1.3 Go-live 06-2024

SLO release 1.4 Go-live 03-2025

TPL release 2.0 (maintenance + improvements)

Template / Rollout –Template implementation HABERKORN

Build Template v1

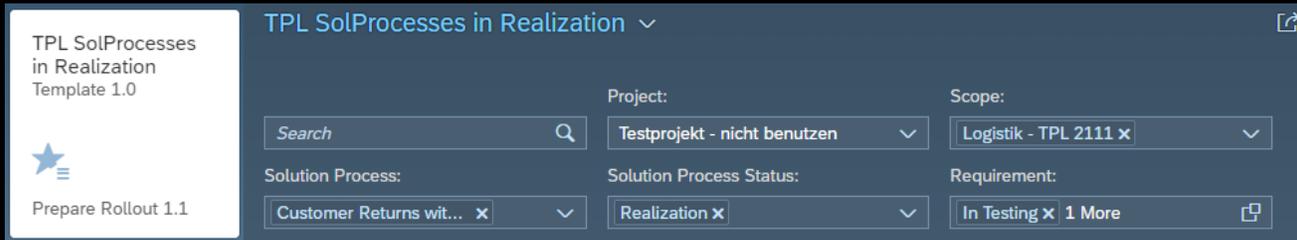
(4) Set scoped Template **Solution Process** in **Realization**.

Example: Customer Returns with Direct Shipment from Customer to Supplier (1Z3)

(5) **Requirement** based on Process Name with additional extension

Example: TPL-REQ Customer Returns with Direct Shipment from Customer to Supplier (1Z3)

(6) All TPL **Requirements In Testing**

Template / Rollout – Rollout preparation

HABERKORN

Prepare and Build Rollout v1.1

(7) Filter all Template **Processes** by **Realization** (later include **Production** and **Maintenance**)

A. No localization required

- ❑ Document as “Not Planned”

B. In case of required localization without process adjustment

- ❑ Create **Requirement** by certain name extension
- ❑ Example: ***SAL-REQ** Customer Returns with Direct Shipment from Customer to Supplier (1Z3)*

C. In case of required localization with process adjustment

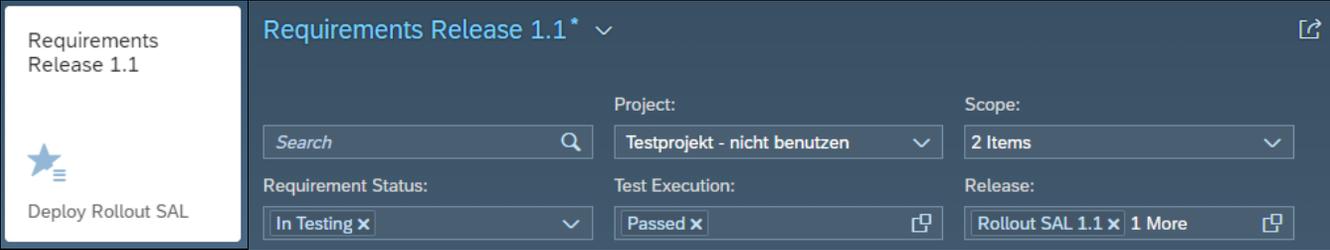
- ❑ Create **Requirement** by certain name extension (priority and status **In Approval**)
- ❑ Example: ***SAL-REQ** Customer Returns with Direct Shipment from Customer to Supplier (1Z3)*
- ❑ Create copy of **Process** by certain name extension and assign in template process.
- ❑ Example: ***SAL** Customer Returns with Direct Shipment from Customer to Supplier (1Z3)*

Template / Rollout – Rollout 1 Go-live HABERKORN

Rollout 1 finalization and Go-live

(8) All Requirements assigned to a certain **Release 1.1** require a completed test documentation

Release 1.1 include Requirements of Template (v1.0) and Rollout 1



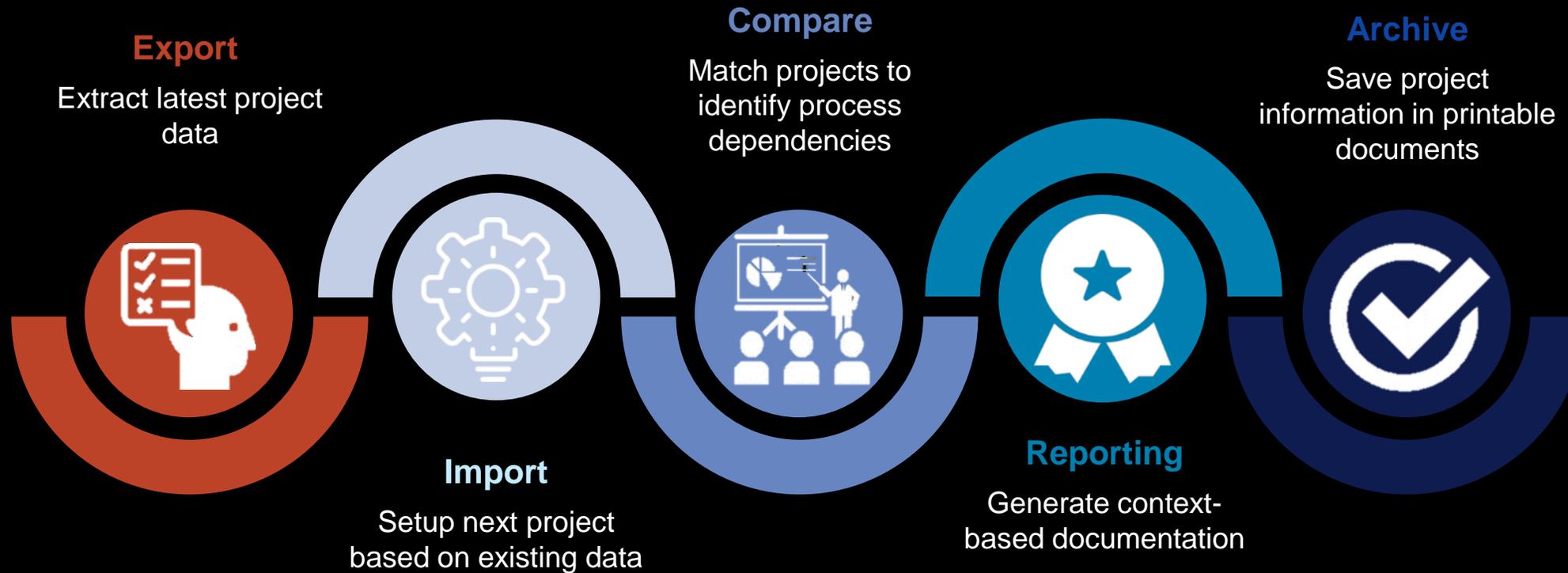
