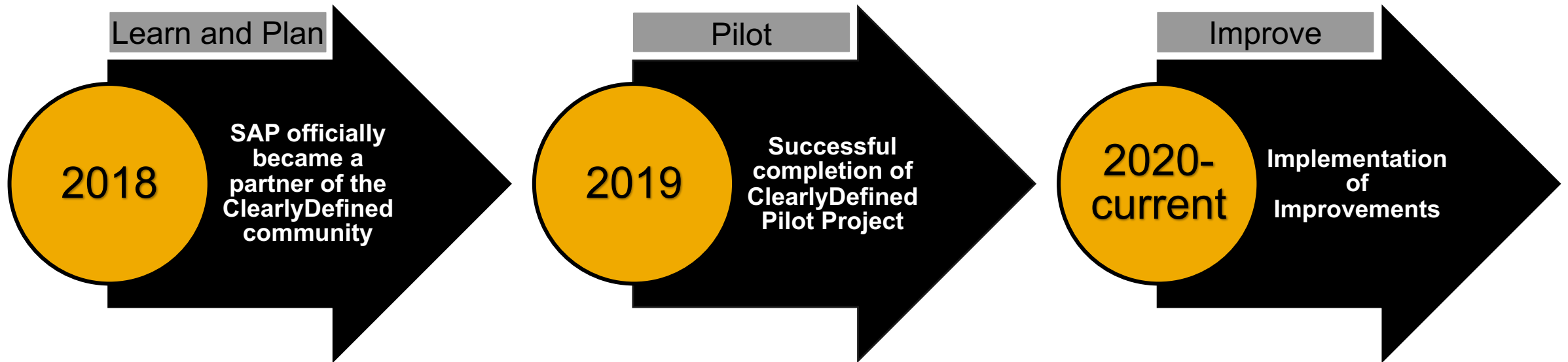

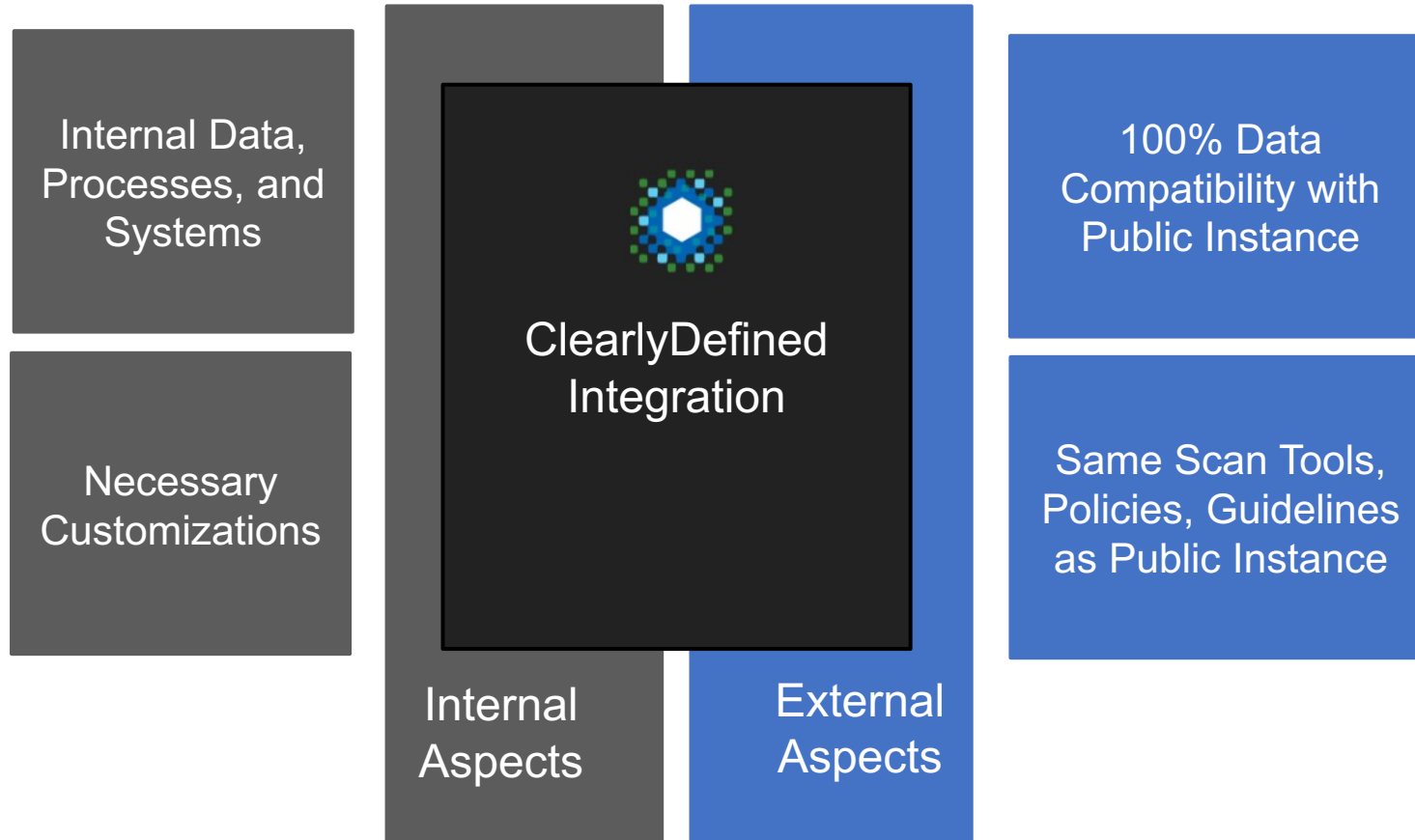

We need flexibility to adapt to meet our own implementation mandate.

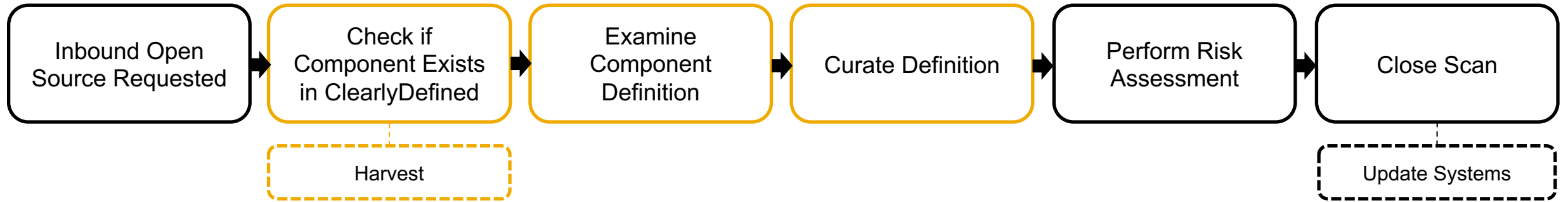
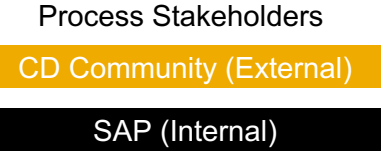


Side B

FOSS Review Process (2019)



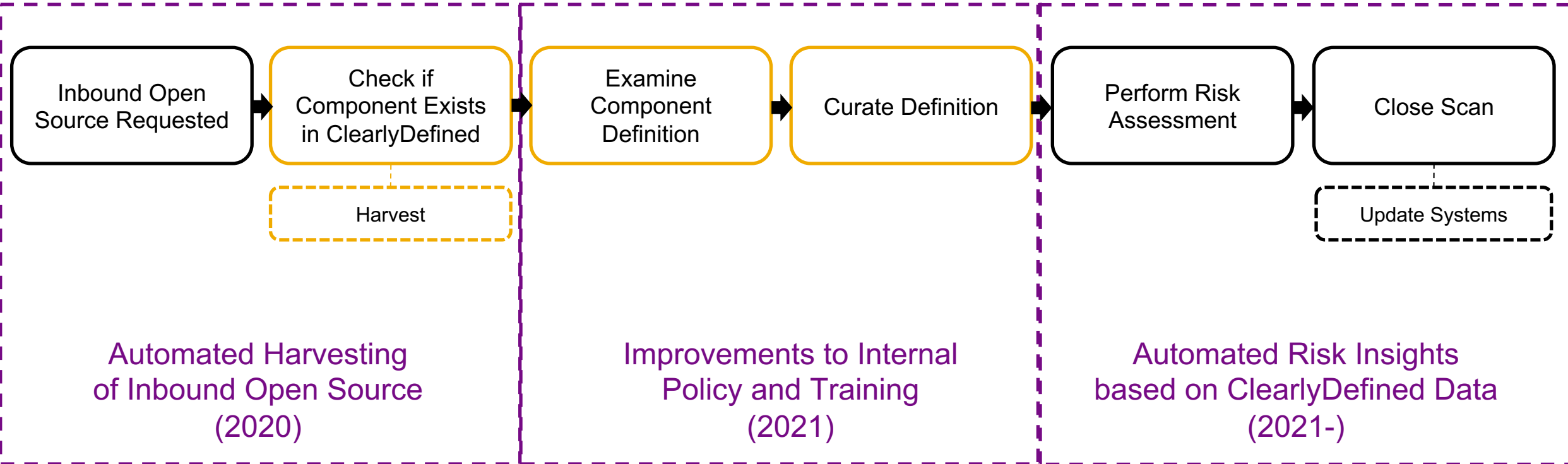

FOSS Review Process (2020)

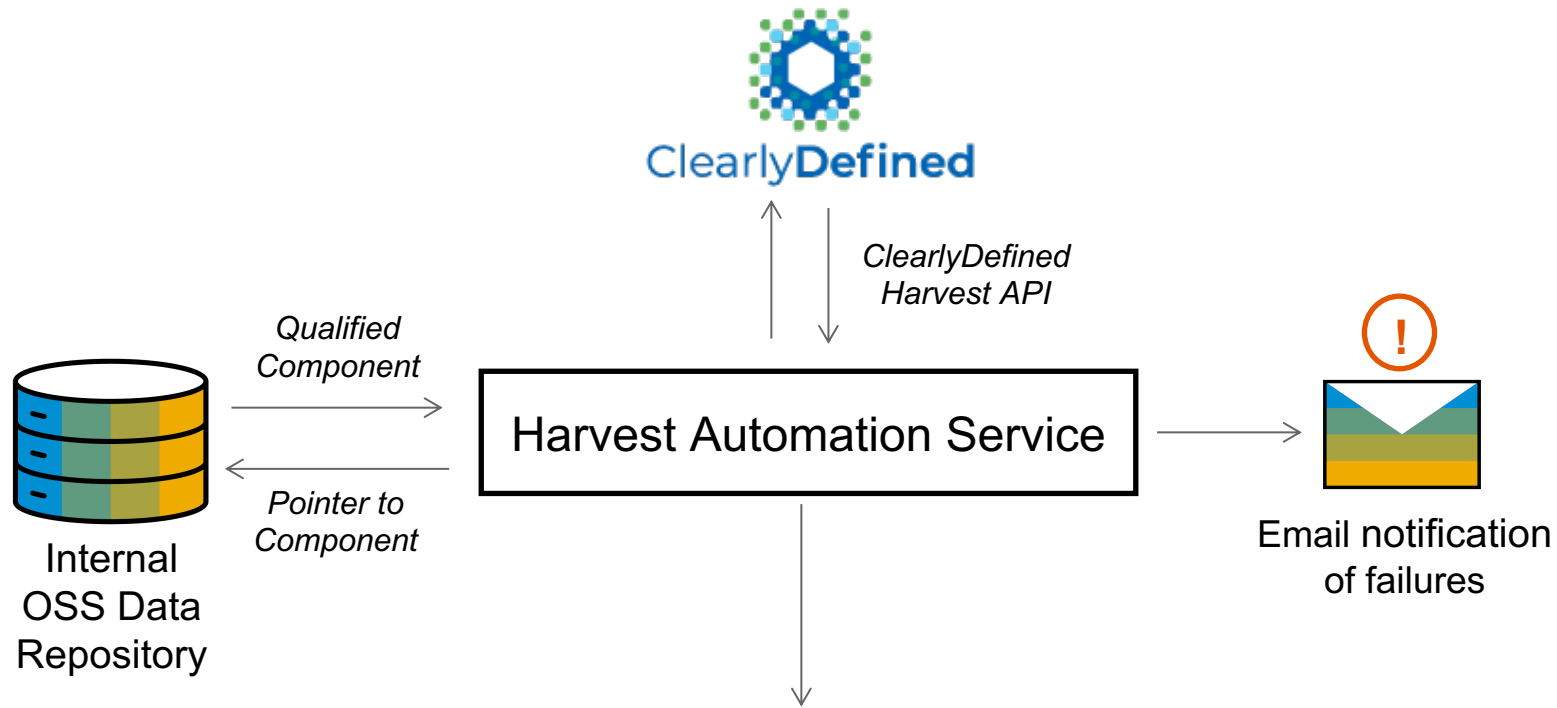

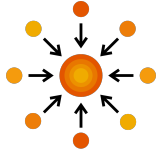
