



Definition of seamless


Without any seams joining two or more pieces of cloth

- → Strategic priority







The details can be found in the numerous legibility enhancements including: wider character apexes, larger apertures and more open counters, decreased character ambiguity and open terminals.




SAP Concur – Home Screen












