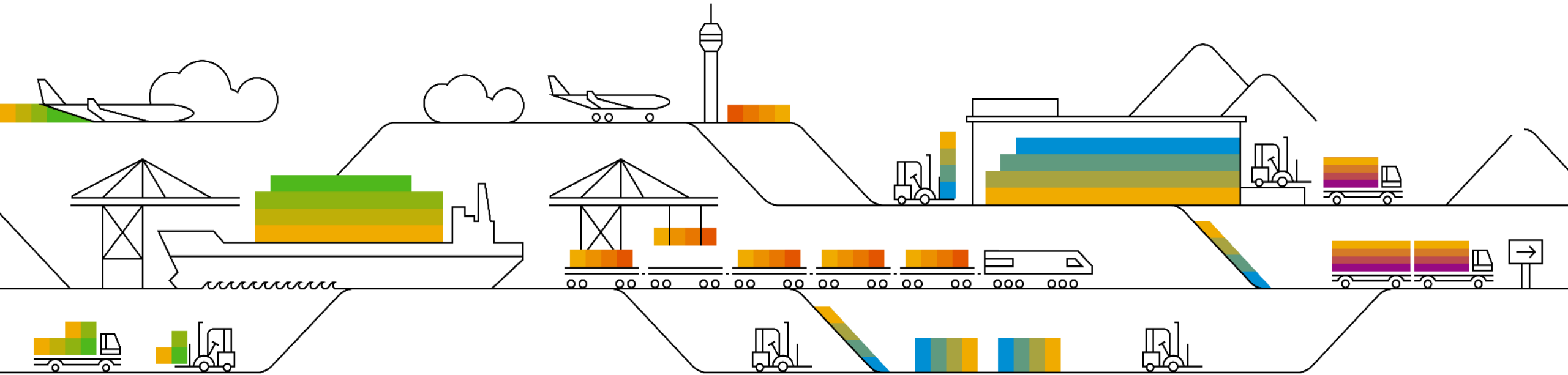

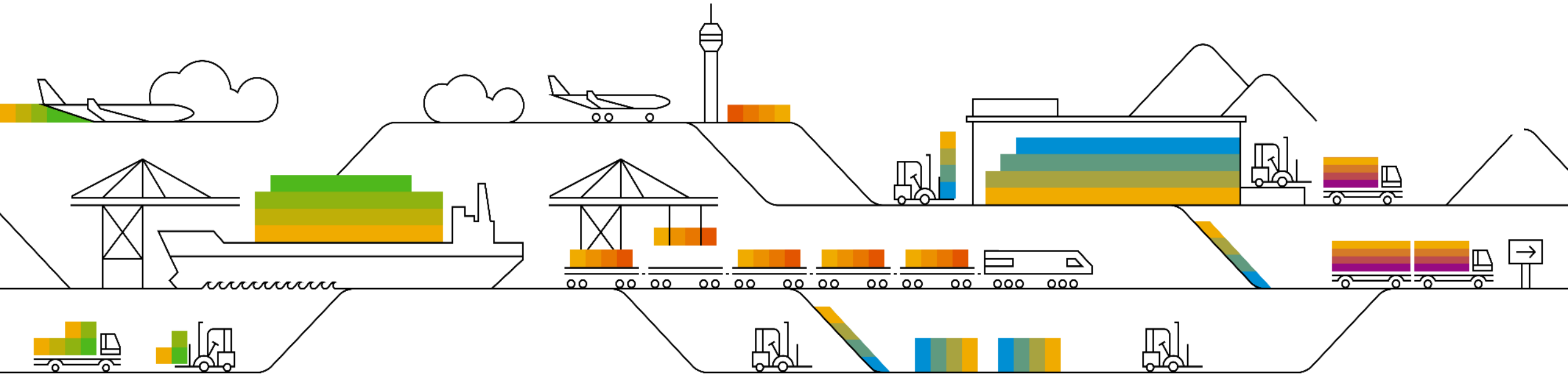

Update to ELSTER Adapter

This software release contains an update for the ELSTER receiver adapter. The German tax authorities have released a new version (33.4.4.0) of the ERiC (ELSTER Rich Client) library. This update requires version 12 for the ELSTER data collection (Datenabholung).

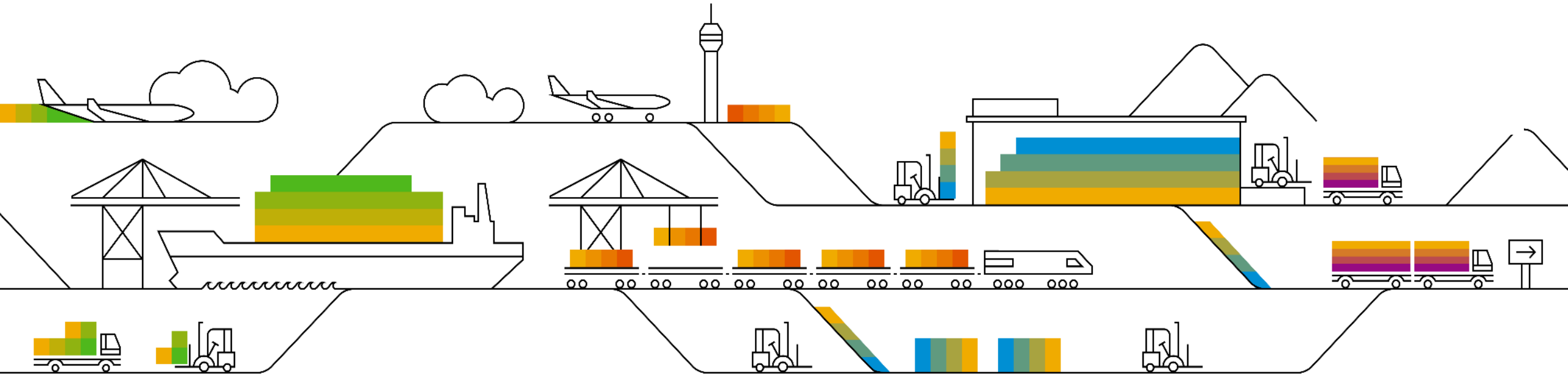
If you use the ELSTER adapter, in particular, together with the data collection method for ETStmt (LStB) and ELStAM, make sure that you implement the following SAP note [3067520](#) in your HR system.

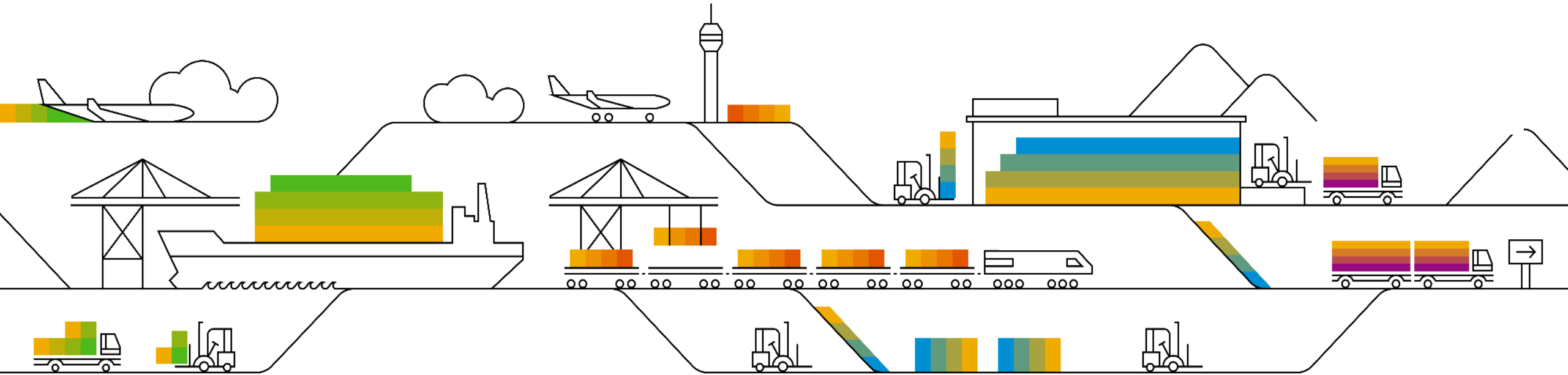
Other updates

- Now, you can upload and deploy type-4 compliant IBM DB2 JDBC drivers in runtime to access DB2 database. See: [Configure JDBC Drivers](#)
- With this release, script collection artifacts and integration packages are also scanned for malware before upload. See: [Malware Scanner](#)
- You can now select the option Keep File and Process Again for the SFTP Sender Adapter used with the Poll Enrich Step to allow repeated and parallel access to the same file without moving or deleting it.
- You can now define the poll interval for both the XI Sender and the XI Receiver adapter, specifying the waiting time before a new attempt is made to consume messages from the data store.

- The data store default expiry period was changed from 90 to 30 days.
- REST and SOAP APIs can also be protected using access policies.
- SuccessFactors SOAP Receiver Adapter now supports OAuth2 credentials.

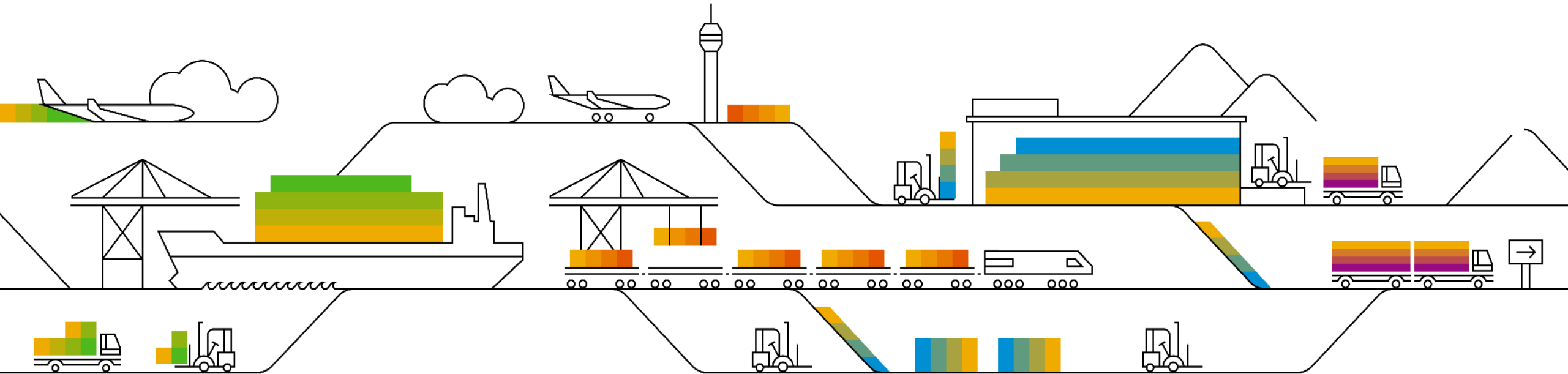

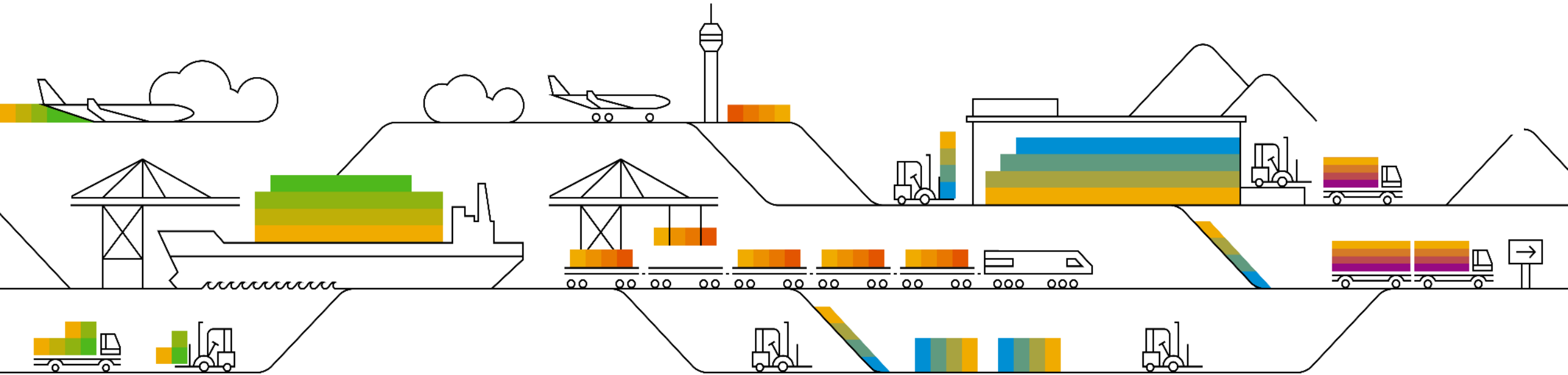

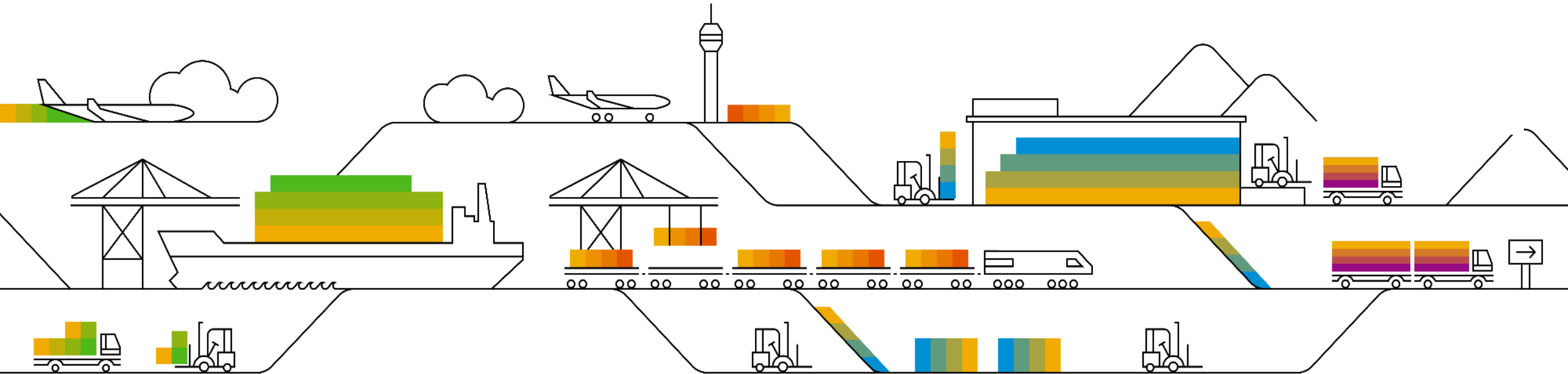
