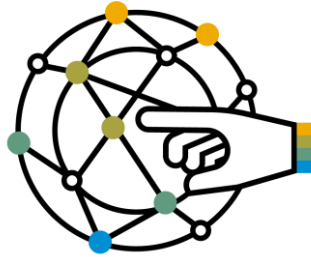

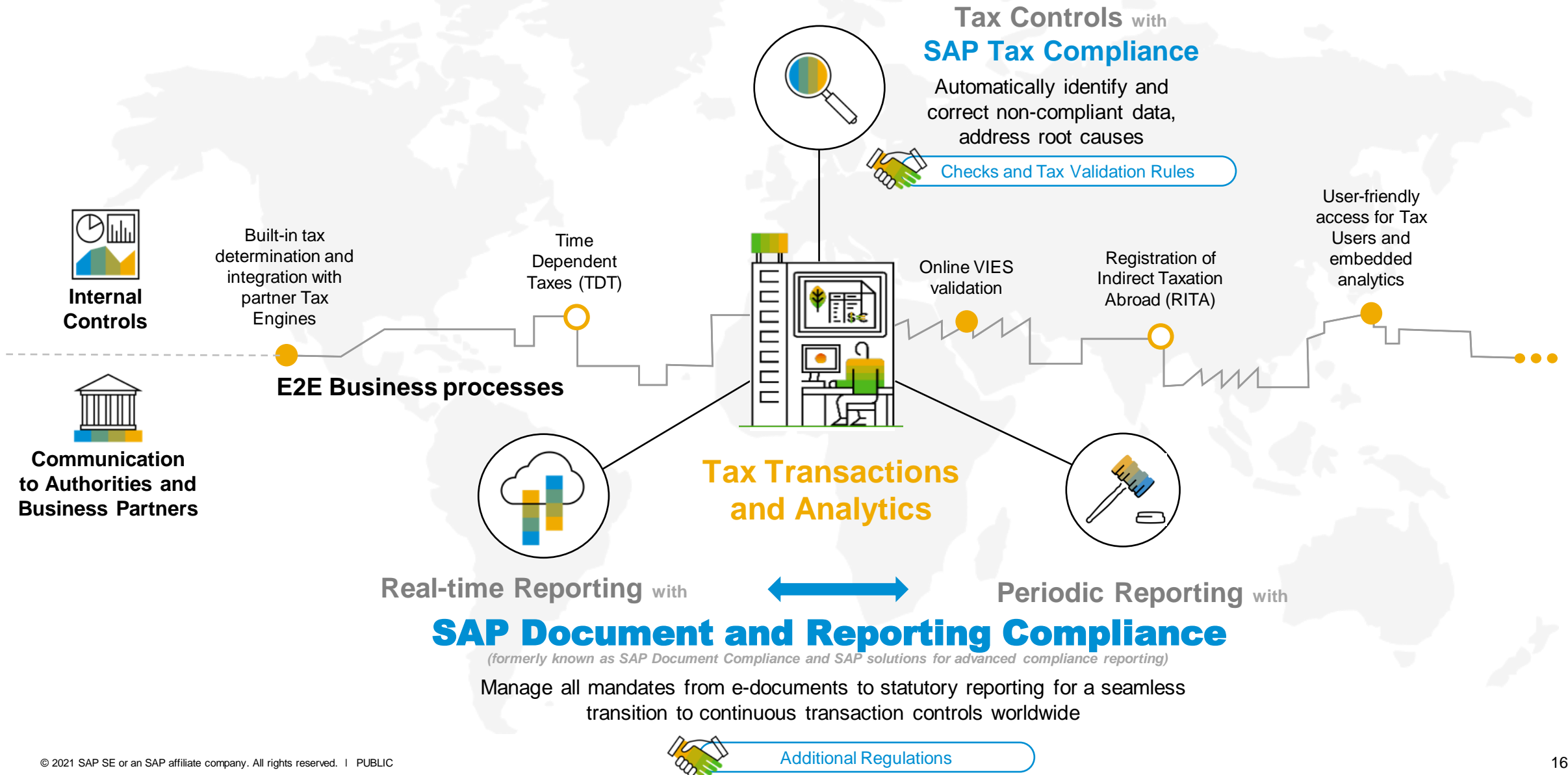
Adoption Mandates

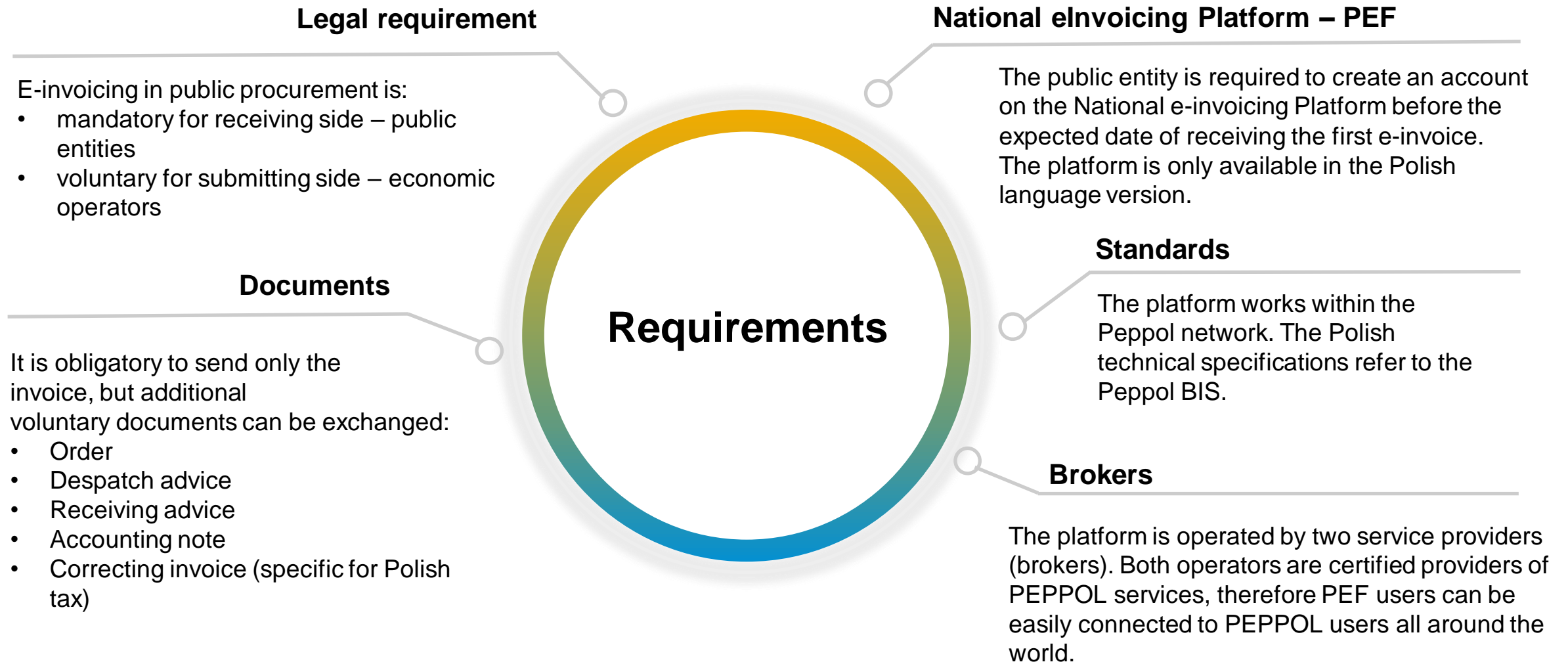
Directive 2014/55/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of **April 16, 2014** on electronic invoicing in public procurement

In Poland new regulations for **B2G** came into force on **April 18, 2019** (legal act: Dz.U. 2018 poz. 2191):

- e-invoicing in public procurement is mandatory for receiving side
- e-invoicing in public procurement is voluntary for submitting side

The new e-invoicing legislation for **B2B** in Poland is in preparation. The expectation is that the new rules would be optional from **January 1, 2022** and obligatory from **January 1, 2023**.

The solution allows you to create and process invoices by using the eDocument Cockpit app



The system maps the transactional data from the source document into the required XML format required in Poland



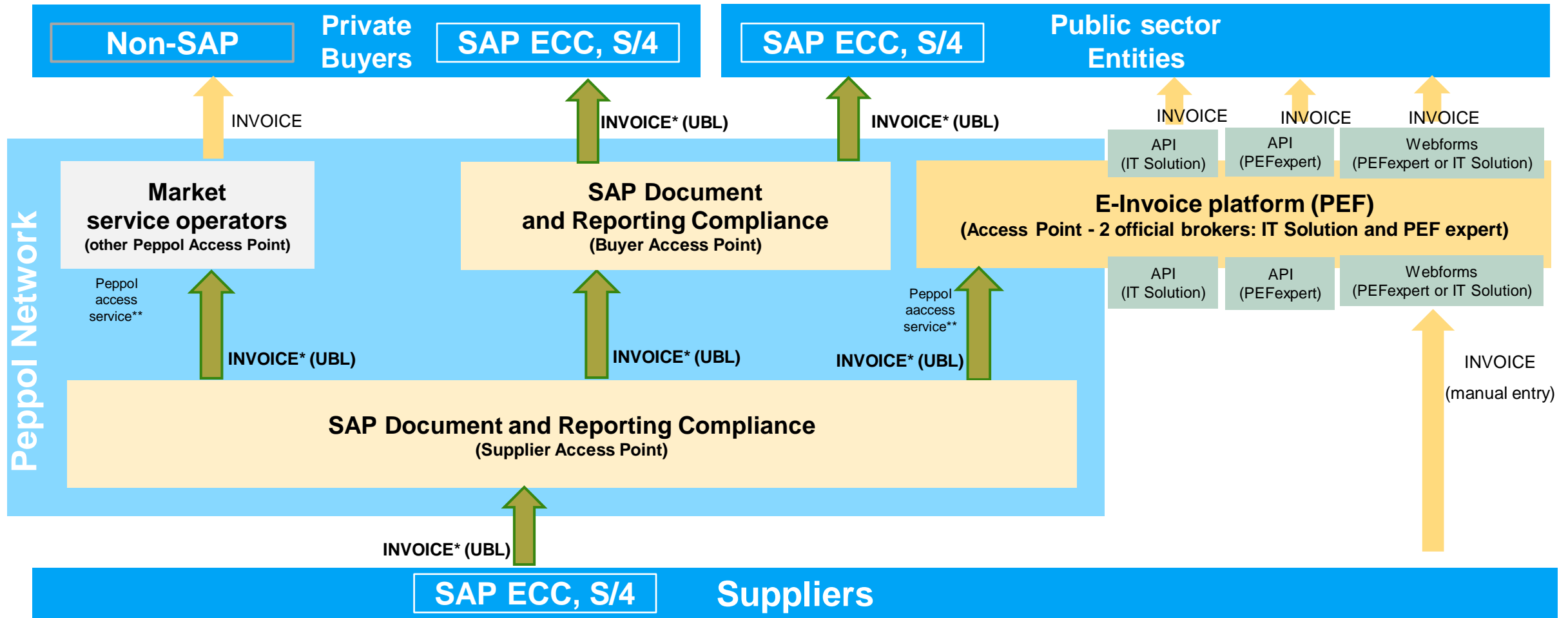
The system calls Peppol Exchange that acts as the Peppol access point and the service sends the XML file to the receiver access point



The receiver access point sends delivery notification and the system updates the eDocument and displays the current status of the eDocument in the eDocument Cockpit

Introduction

The Council of Ministers has released a project of legal change to amend the Act of March 11, 2004 on tax on goods and services (Journal of Laws of 2020, item 106, as amended), hereinafter referred to as the "VAT Act".

- This announcement contains information about the project of legal change introducing "*Krajowy System e-Faktur (KSeF)*".
- This information is based on legislation and regulations that are subject to change at any time by the respective authorities and is therefore not a guarantee.

Update 17.08.2021

The introduction of the Polish E-invoicing system will be postponed until January 2022. Initially the system was planned to be operational in October 2021. The e-invoicing system will remain voluntary in the beginning.

Business Background/Impact

Krajowy System e-Faktur (KSeF) is an information system for issuing and receiving structured invoices, as well as for their storing, marking with the specified invoice template.

The issuing structured invoices will be another accepted form of documenting sales, next to paper invoices and electronic invoices currently in the market.

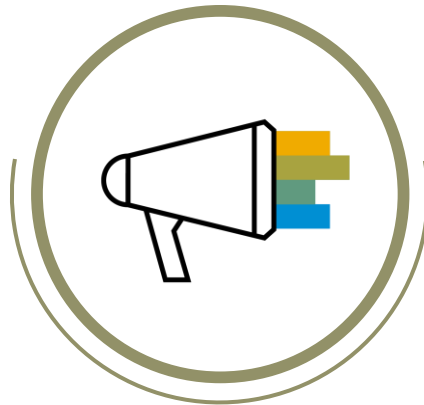
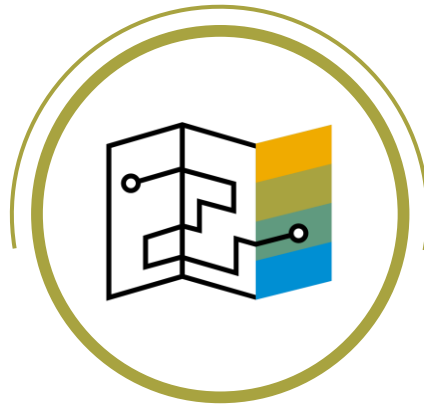

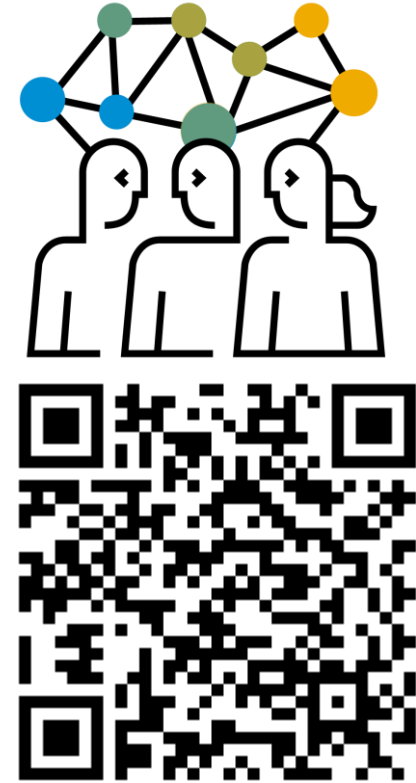
