




# New Features for ServiceNow Adapter

## General features




Version 1.3 of Adapter has new features:

- **Upload Binary:** Enables the upload of files to ServiceNow.
- **Retrieve Content:** Retrieve the content of an attachment file from ServiceNow.
- **Retrieve Metadata:** Retrieve the attributes that describes an attachment file from ServiceNow.
- **Query Metadata:** Perform search and queries on attachments based on request message.
- **Delete:** Removes a file from ServiceNow.

# Optimization of the timeout propagation for API proxies

The connection to the backend is released earlier if the "io.timeout.millis" value is set lower than the default value, thereby improving the performance of the API proxy.



# New Passthrough Option in AMQP Receiver Adapter

In the AMQP Receiver Adapter you can now use the **Passthrough** option to forward the message header name without transformation.

# OData API Updates

- New **POST** and **DELETE** operations have been added to the **Message Mappings** resource of the Integration Content OData API. These new operations support the creation and deletion of message mappings through the API.
- The new resource **Script Collection** has been added to the **Integration Content** OData API. You can **create** and **upload** a script collection, **add resources** to a script collection, and **deploy** a script collection.
- A new operation has been added to the **Value Mappings** resource of the Integration Content OData API that allows you to **delete entries** from value mappings.
