

## SAP S/4HANA: Relation with SAP Business Suite





# **Compatibility Packs in SAP S/4HANA**Motivation

Why allow the use of Compatibility Packs on SAP S/4HANA?

- Make transition easier for customers using SAP ERP/Business Suite
- Allow sufficient time for redesign of business processes under S/4HANA



# **Compatibility Packs in SAP S/4HANA**Definition

SAP grants a timely restricted<sup>(1)</sup> use right for specific classic SAP solution functionality<sup>(2)</sup> to SAP S/4HANA customers, at no extra cost<sup>(3)</sup>

- (1) restricted until the end of 2025\* (initially: 2020!)
- (2) Positive list of compatibility packs as documented in note <a href="2269324">2269324</a> and referenced in the Software Use Rights (SUR)
- (3) condition: customer has licensed SAP S/4HANA Enterprise Management and the classic solution

Compatibility Packs are only applicable for solutions which are installed on the SAP S/4HANA instance — not for side-by-side installations.

SAP aims to replace these classic solutions by the end of 2023 with a genuine SAP S/4HANA solution.

# Compatibility Packs in SAP S/4HANA CP Matrix and Licensing

A CP is an S/4HANA compatible copy of a "classic" = Business Suite software product.

All CPs are listed on the Compatibility Scope Matrix. It contains:

- complete or partial solutions
- LoB/Industry-solutions (IDs 1xx) and core solutions (IDs 4xx)
- Additional information to better identify the scope
   and cross-link information (as applicable application component, link to Simplification Item, ID)

The CP Matrix is release-independent and static.

CPs exist in on-premise and selected private cloud deployments.

Licensing example: Net new customer from the Chemicals Industry:

- Customer licenses:
  - SAP S/4HANA Enterprise Management users [7018652, 7018653, 7018654]
  - SAP EHS Management, Product Safety [7010170] -> on CP matrix
- Customer may install EHS-Product Safety (a) on-stack on his S/4HANA system or (b) side-by-side




Running a classic SAP ERP solution side-by-side with SAP S/4HANA does not require a Compatibility Pack.

# Compatibility Packs in SAP S/4HANA

# Compatibility Packs in SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition

- CPs were defined in an on-premise world  $\rightarrow$  prerequisite = perpetual license.
- CP use rights as temporary use rights: also exist in various private cloud models without the OP license prerequisite. Leading document: Service Description Guide.
- Most core-licensed CPs (IDs 4\*\*) are also valid in private cloud.
  - Examples: Project System, Customer Service, LE-TRA
  - Exceptions: Travel Management (FI-TV) and HCM were never covered by a CP use right in private cloud, but explicitly excluded (FSD, SDG). They are accessible via specific licenses, e.g. SAP Travel Management for SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition (8016042) or SAP Core Human Capital Management Cloud, private edition (8008910). Their commercial models are aligned with the strategic solutions, Concur and SuccessFactors.
- Most LoB- or industry-licensed CPs (IDs 1\*\*) do not exist in private cloud, because a subscription license for them is in place. Examples:





# **SAP S/4HANA – managing simplifications**

A simplification item documents differences in application functionality (changed, replaced, removed) between version 6.0 of SAP ERP and SAP S/4HANA, as well as in between different versions of SAP S/4HANA.


- A simplification item provides information about the potential impact of this change for the customer.
- The simplification list is a collection of simplification items.
- The simplification list provides this information per the SAP S/4HANA release as part of the SAP S/4HANA documentation.
- The SAP Readiness Check tool for SAP S/4HANA, the ABAP custom code analysis, and the simplification item checks are based on the information in the simplification items.
- In case dedicated simplification items require mandatory preparation steps, the technical conversion/upgrade procedure can stop to help ensure a consistent system conversion.

→ Within your transition or upgrade project, run the <u>simplification items checks</u> as soon as possible, as some business process adaptations may be complex and require more time than expected. Remember: Your SAP ERP knowledge still counts!

# **SAP Note 293 1193 - Explanation of Simplification Item Categories**

# Simplification items related to functionality in compatibility scope can have one of the following four categories:


- Non-Strategic Function (alternative exists)
   An alternative functionality is available in SAP S/4HANA as of the specified target release and this alternative functionality is expected to already fulfill all major requirements of most customers who did use the old functionality before.
- Non-Strategic Function (alternative exists with roadmap)

  An alternative functionality is available in SAP S/4HANA as of the specified target release. However the alternative functionality still has major gaps compared to the old functionality, and hence cannot serve as a replacement yet for all customers. A roadmap exists to fill these gaps.
- Non-Strategic Function (alternative planned)
   An alternative functionality is not yet available in SAP S/4HANA as of the specified target release. However a roadmap exists for providing an alternative functionality.
- Non-Strategic Function (no alternative planned)
   An alternative functionality is not available in SAP S/4HANA and there are currently no concrete plans to provide an alternative functionality.





# Example 1: Project System (IDs 459 – 472)

#### Solution strategy

■ Most of the CP items' functionalities will be transferred to perpetual scope with release 2023, applying S/4HANA technologies, but mostly non-disruptive. Some functionalities remain CPs and expire end of 2025. Consult the respective notes via the WayForward excel.

## Compatibility Pack userights


SAP customers were informed that the usage rights for Compatibility Scope will expire on December 31, 2025 based upon board decision, SAP will provide a selective and specific extension of Compatibility Scope usage rights to December 31, 2030 for Transportation (LE-TRA), Customer Service (CS), and selected Production Planning in Process Industry (PP-PI) items on an exceptional basis.

Detailed information about available alternative functionality can be found in SAP Note #2269324. The S4HANA CompScope - Way Forward - Info.xlsx provides a list of corresponding business impact notes for each Compatibility Scope item with further details about the alternative solution in SAP S/4HANA, if any, in the note attachments

SAP is neither currently planning to use programmed dumps or blocks nor to delete code or transactions on short notice. However, SAP strongly recommends that customers check their Compatibility Scope usage well in advance to start their transition on time and to plan accordingly. This way customers can reduce change management efforts for the adoption of a new data model.

# **Selective Extension of Compatibility Pack Usage Rights**

SAP grants a **timely restricted usage** right for specific classic solution functionalities in the context of SAP S/4HANA. These term licenses are limited to the end of 2025, and are defined by the **compatibility scope**. SAP intends to provide new go-to functionalities for all compatibility scope items by 2023. Many of them can already be phased out today. This transition from compatibility scope to the new go-to solutions is in most cases primarily a technical adoption and can be conducted with moderate effort.

For the compatibility scope items of three components (Customer Service, Transport, and Production Planning for Process Industries) the new go-to solutions provide enhanced capabilities and will require a more extensive transformation project, especially for global organizations and customers who leverage individual extensions today.

More details on affected application components' CP items can be found in **SAP Note** 2269324:

- Customer Service (CS) IDs 402-413
- Transport (LE-TRA) ID 474
- Production Planning for Process Industries (PP-PI)
   IDs 444, 446, 447, 453-457

In order to help customers get the highest business value from their SAP S/4HANA systems, SAP has decided to align the usage rights for the compatibility pack items of those three application components with the SAP Business Suite maintenance timeline. **SAP is extending the usage rights exclusively for the compatibility pack items of Customer Service, Transport, and Production Planning for Process Industries (cf. box) until the end of 2030.** 

This extension will be **available to all SAP S/4HANA customers** in SAP S/4HANA Cloud, private edition as well as those with an SAP S/4HANA on-premise deployment and is limited to the CP items listed above (box). The extension comes at no additional cost and does not require any contractual changes or amendments for existing customers as the change is being implemented centrally.
